IONIA PUBLIC SCHOOLS BUILDING AND SITE SINKING FUND TAX PROPOSAL

This proposal, if approved by the electors, will allow the Ionia Public Schools to levy a building and site sinking fund tax, the proceeds of which will be used to make improvements and repairs to the School District's facilities or any other purpose allowed under Michigan law. Pursuant to State Law, the expenditure of the building and site sinking fund tax proceeds must be audited, and the proceeds cannot be used for teacher, administrator or employee salaries, maintenance or other operating expenses.

Shall the Ionia Public Schools be authorized to levy three (3.00) mills (\$3.00 per \$1,000 of taxable valuation), for a period of ten (10) years, from July 1, 2018 through and including December 1, 2027, to create a building and site sinking fund to be used for the construction or repair of school buildings or any other purpose authorized under Michigan law? This millage would provide estimated revenues to the Ionia Public Schools of approximately one million one hundred thirty-six thousand three hundred thirty-three dollars (\$1,136,333) Dollars during the 2018 calendar year, if approved and levied.

Portland Public Schools – Bonding Proposal

Shall Portland Public Schools, Ionia, Clinton and Eaton Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Four Million Nine Hundred Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$24,965,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, in one or more series, for the purpose of:

Erecting, furnishing and equipping an addition to Oakwood Elementary School; remodeling, equipping and re-equipping and furnishing and refurnishing school buildings; erecting a new salt storage building; erecting, furnishing and equipping new concessions and restrooms at the athletic complex; acquiring, installing and equipping or re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; and developing, improving and equipping playgrounds, athletic facilities, athletic fields, play fields and sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2018, under current law, is 1.73 mills (\$1.73 on each \$1000 of taxable valuation) for a 0 mill net increase over the prior year's levy. The maximum number of years the bonds of any series may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty-eight (28) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 3.98 mills (\$3.98 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district expects to borrow from the State School Bond Qualification and Loan Program to pay debt service on these bonds. The estimated total principal amount of that borrowing is \$1,209,656 and the estimated total interest to be paid thereon is \$2,812,302. The estimated duration of the millage levy associated with that borrowing is 14 years and the estimated computed millage rate for such levy is 7.35 mills. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$12,925,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is approximately \$6,161,135.

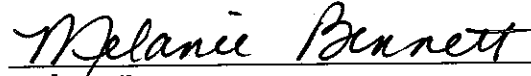

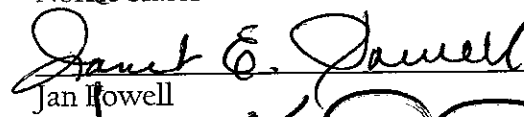

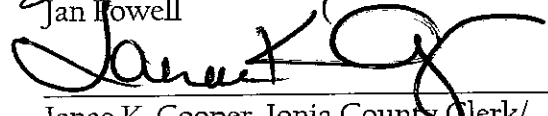

SARANAC COMMUNITY SCHOOLS BONDING PROPOSAL

Shall Saranac Community Schools, Ionia County, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$5,500,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor, for the purpose of:

Remodeling, equipping and re-equipping and furnishing and refurnishing school buildings; acquiring, installing, equipping and re-equipping school buildings for instructional technology; purchasing school buses; and developing and improving sites?

The following is for informational purposes only:

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2018, under current law, is 0 mill (\$0.00 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is 20 years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 1.62 mills (\$1.62 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district expects to borrow from the State School bond Qualification and Loan Program to pay debt service on these bonds. The estimated total principal amount of that borrowing is \$1,136,313 and the estimated total interest to be paid thereon is \$3,058,652. The estimated duration of the millage levy associated with that borrowing is 18 years and the estimated computed millage rate for such levy is 9.00 mills. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$18,305,000. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is approximately \$6,140,321.
