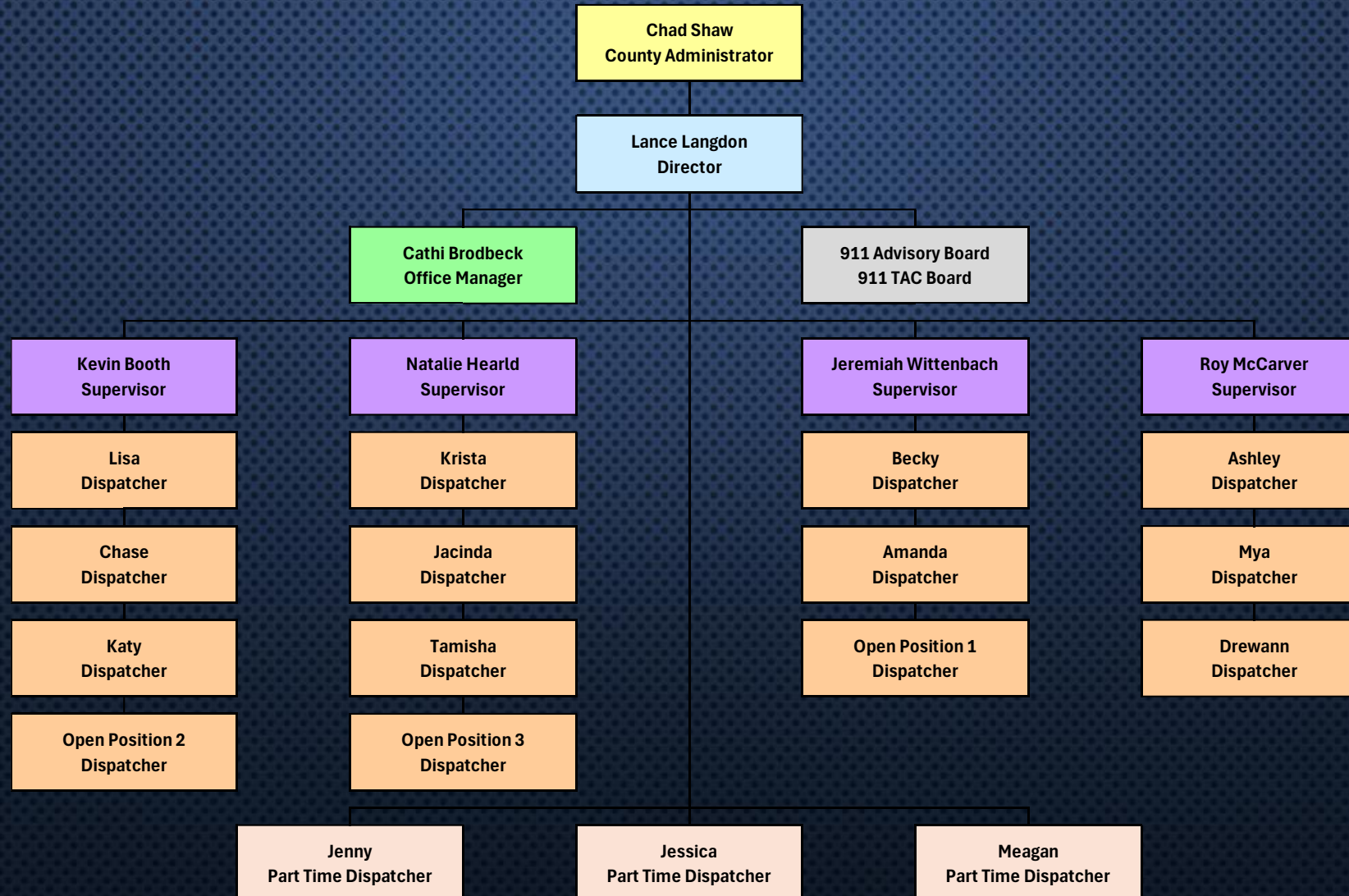

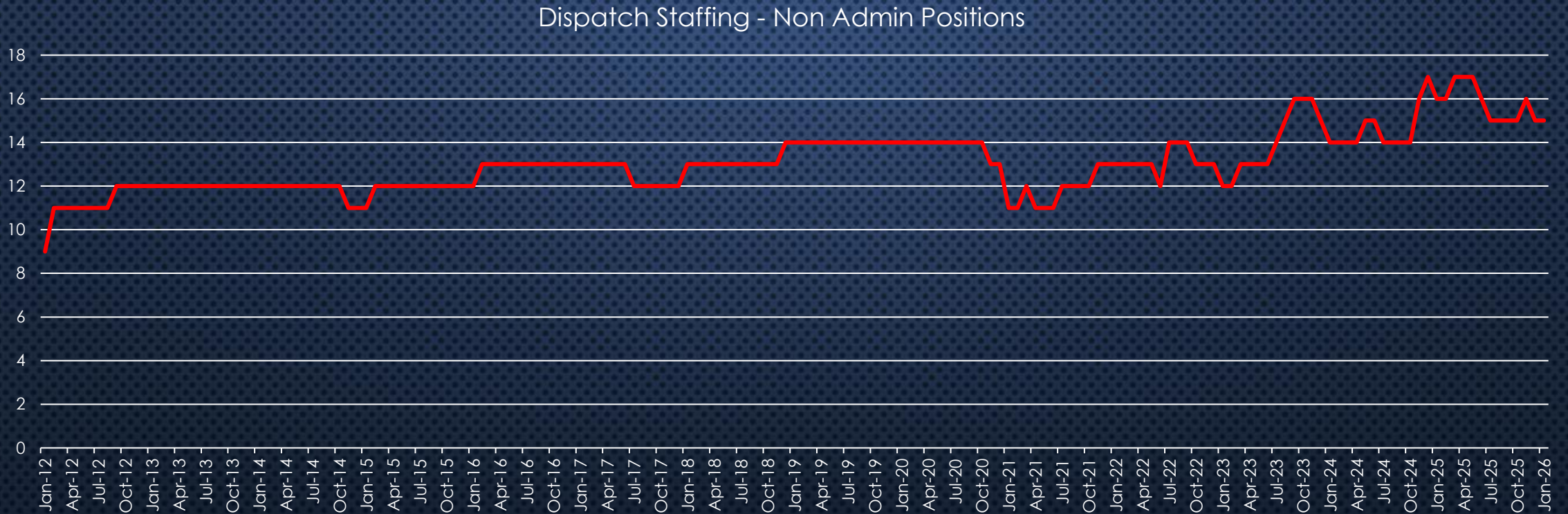

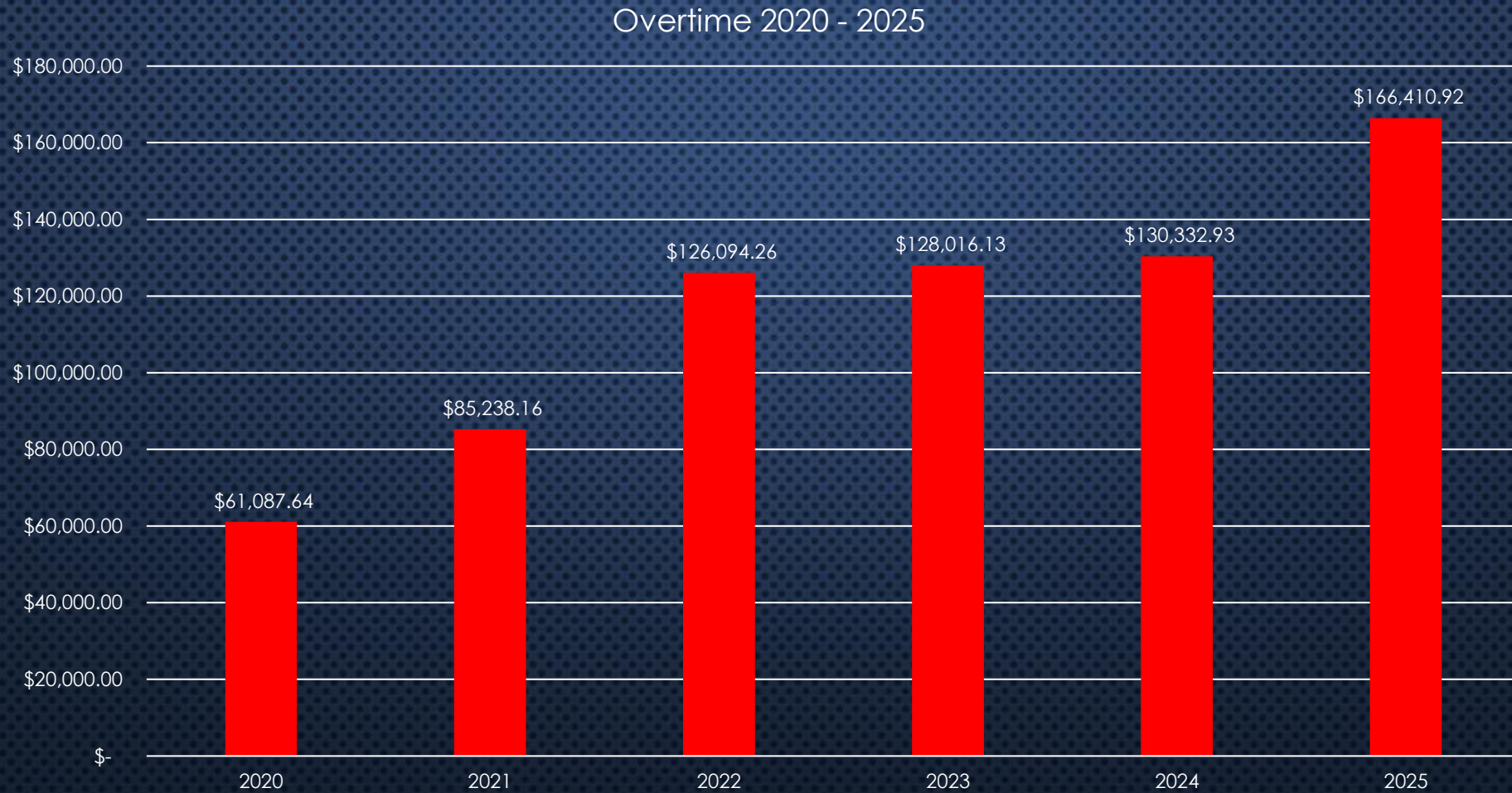
Staffing increased from 11 to 12 Dispatchers July of 2022.

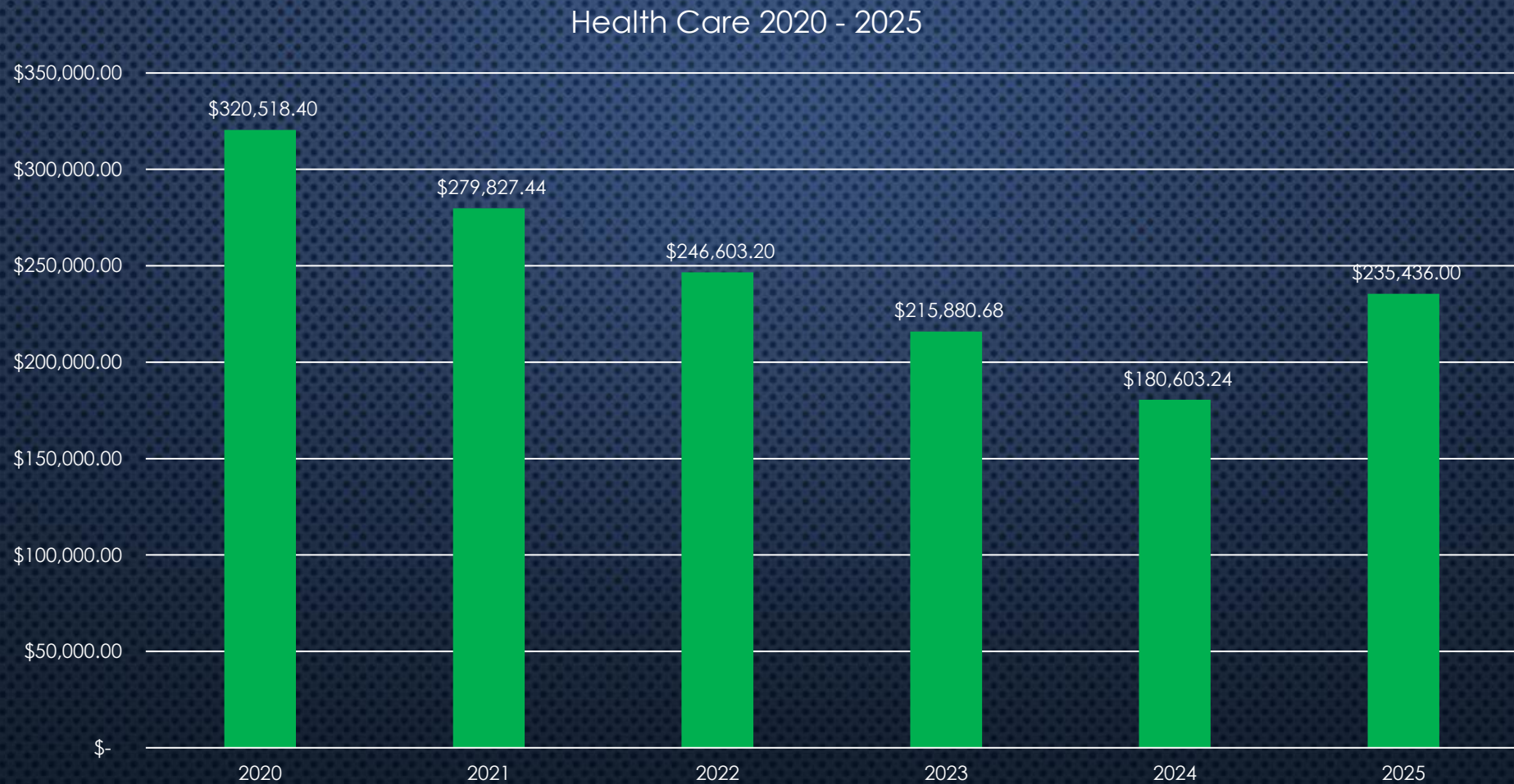
- SIGNIFICANT PAYROLL INCREASES MADE POST COVID COUNTY WIDE.

OVERTIME COSTS – BY YEAR



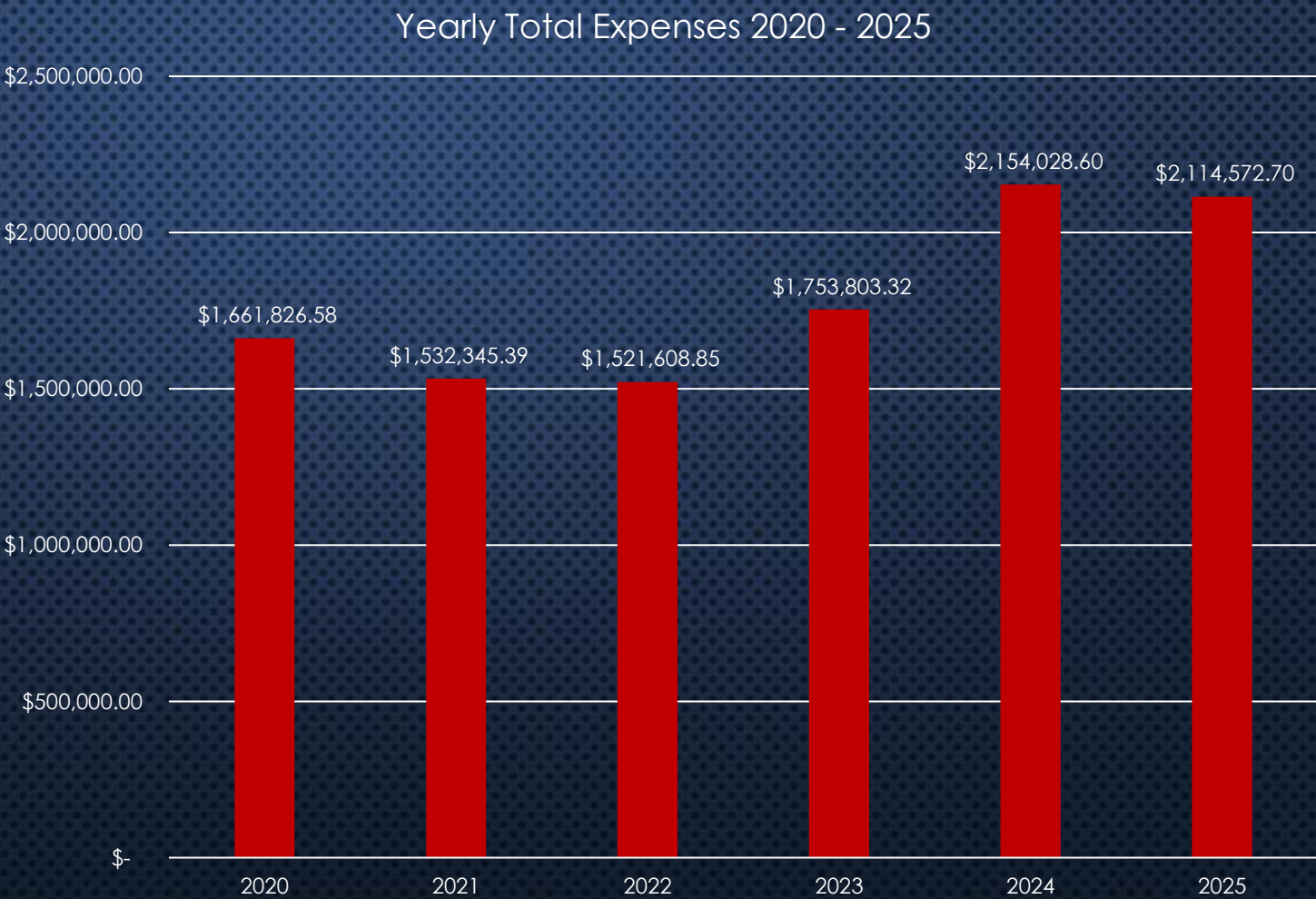


HEALTH CARE COSTS – BY YEAR

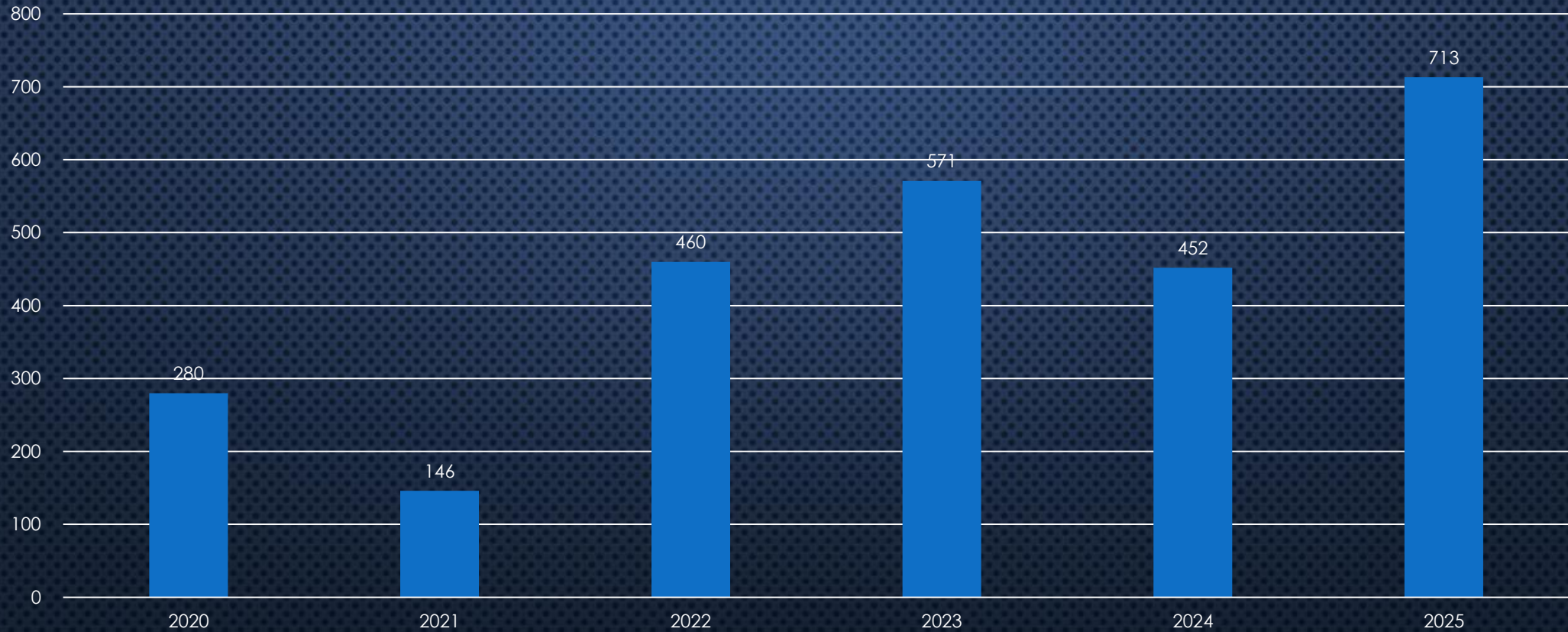
9-1-1 Training Funds Received 2020 - 2025

OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS 2025

- A FROZEN PIPE IN OUR NEW CALL CENTER, RESULTED IN MOVING OPERATIONS OVER TO THE TRAINING ROOM (OLD CALL CENTER) WHILE WATER DAMAGE WAS ADDRESSED. NO EQUIPMENT WAS DAMAGED, BUT SECTIONS OF THE CEILING, WALLS AND INSULATION WERE REPLACED AND CLEAN UP OF CARPETING WAS DONE.
- WORK HAS BEEN DONE TO MOVE LAW ENFORCEMENT TO SECURE ENCRYPTED COMMUNICATIONS FOR CJIS COMPLIANCE. THE NEW TALKGROUPS HAVE BEEN ADDED TO THE SYSTEM AND DISPATCH CONSOLES. CURRENTLY WORKING TO ADD THEM TO OUR BACKUP RADIOS, AS WE WAIT FOR THE TEMPLATES TO BE BUILT BY MPSCS.
- 911 FIELD DAY SEPTEMBER 2025. OVER 400 PEOPLE ATTENDED WITH MANY DIFFERENT PUBLIC SAFETY AND COMMUNITY PARTNERS. THIS KICKED OFF THIS YEAR'S PROGRAM WITH THE IONIA CAREER CENTER
- SPAM CALLS ARE NO LONGER AN ISSUE FOR THE CENTER AND DATA ON THEM HAS BEEN REMOVED FROM THIS REPORT.





OPERATIONAL HIGHLIGHTS 2025

- OUR 911 ADVISORY BOARD CHAIR, ROLAND SELF, HAS STEPPED DOWN FROM THE BOARD AFTER APPROXIMATELY 15 YEARS OF SERVICE. HIS SERVICE AND CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE BOARD AND THE COMMUNITY ARE GREATLY APPRECIATED.
- CENTER/STAFF TOOK PART AGAIN WITH HALLOWEEN TRUNK OR TREAT AND CHILI DOG CONTEST. GREAT SUCCESS AS STAFF TALKED WITH FAMILIES ABOUT 9-1-1, ANSWERED QUESTIONS AND WORKED TO RECRUIT NEW MEMBERS. STAFF ALSO TOOK 2ND PLACE IN THE CHILI DOG CONTEST THIS YEAR, AFTER DEALING WITH EQUIPMENT FAILURE.
- STAFFING: AS SEEN WITH OTHER PUBLIC SAFETY STAFFING, WE CONTINUE TO FACE CHALLENGES IN FINDING QUALIFIED APPLICANTS AND FULLY STAFFING THE CENTER. IN 2025, WE WELCOMED THREE NEW EMPLOYEES; HOWEVER, ONE DEPARTED AFTER JUST FOUR MONTHS.
- SHOP WITH A COP/HERO, STAFF AND SANTA JOINED FIRST RESPONDERS AGAIN THIS YEAR.
- TRAINING FOR SUPERVISORS TO ASSIST THEM IN THEIR SUPERVISORY DUTIES WAS ATTENDED WITH AN INCREASED AVAILABILITY OF CLASSES IN 2025.





LOOKING FORWARD IN 2026

- WORK CONTINUES WITH CAREER CENTER PROGRAM, IDENTIFYING POSSIBLE STUDENT INTERNS AND POSSIBLY TO BECOME FULL TIME MEMBERS OF THE ICCD FAMILY/STAFF.
- UPGRADE 911 PHONE SYSTEM IN FIRST HALF OF 2026, WITH MOVE TO A CLOUD-BASED SYSTEM.
- CONTINUE TO SEEK GOOD PEOPLE TO FILL OUR OPEN DISPATCHER POSITIONS.
- MOVE OUR DISPATCHER TRAINING SYSTEM FROM PAPER FORMS TO A NEW DIGITAL SYSTEM IMPROVING DOCUMENTATION PROCESSES AND ENHANCE INDIVIDUAL TRAINING.
- STAFFING CHANGE AHEAD AS OUR OFFICE MANAGER CATHI RETIRES. BEST WISHES AND HAPPY RETIREMENT, WELL DESERVED, SHE WILL BE GREATLY MISSED!

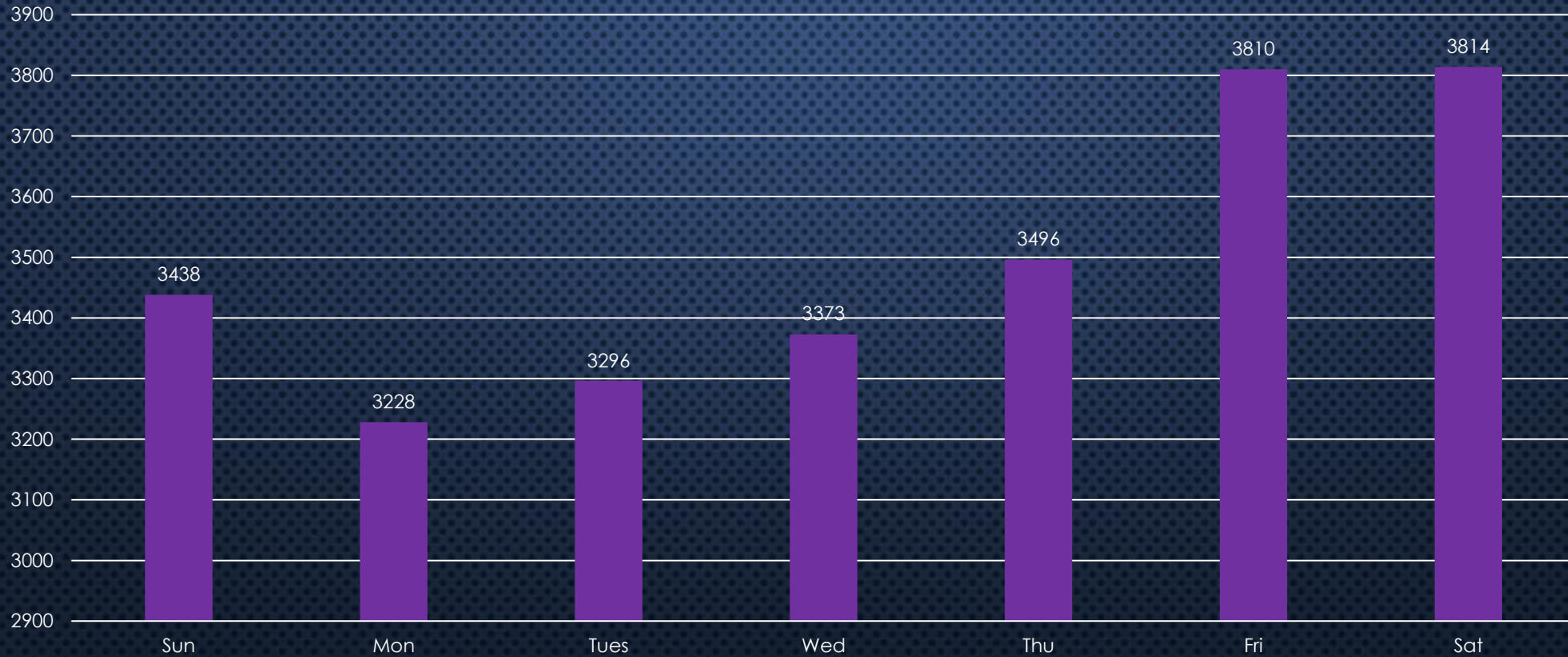

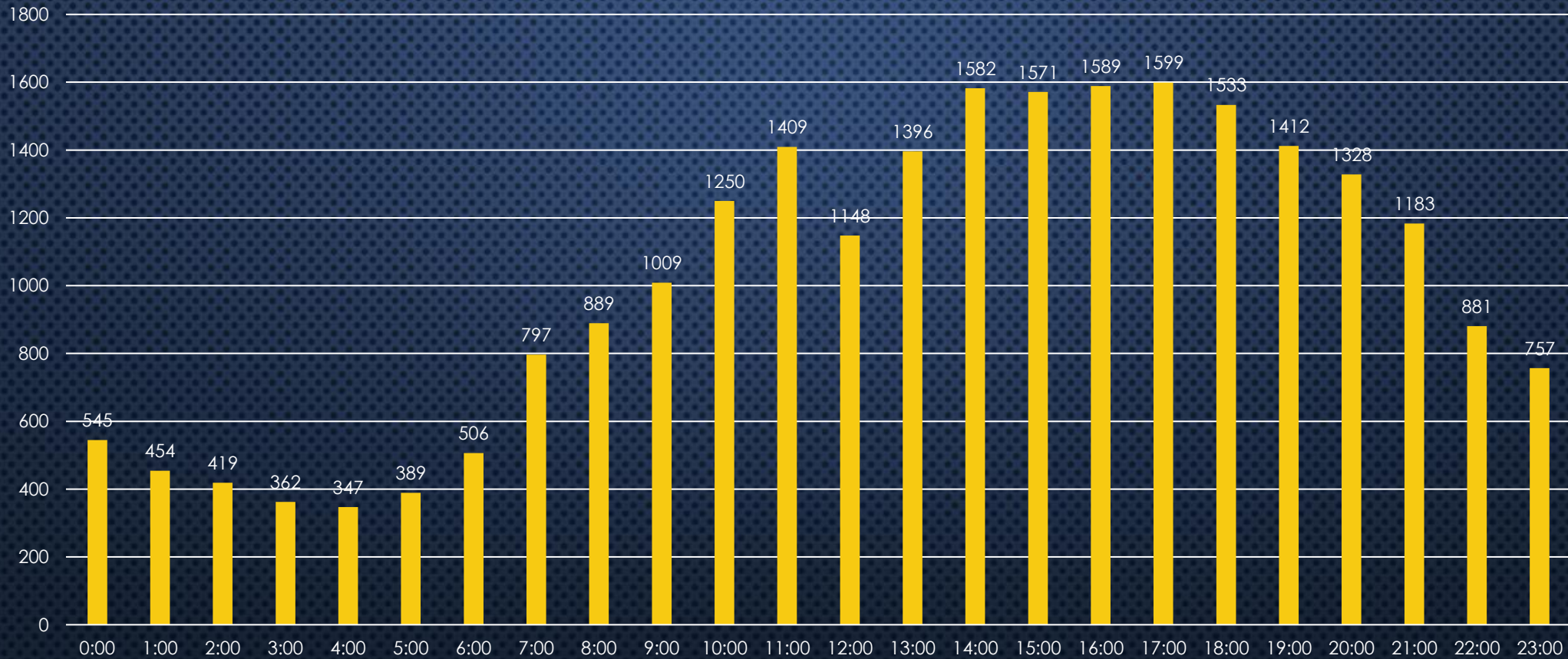
9-1-1 Calls by Day of Week - 2025



911 CALLS BY DAY OF WEEK



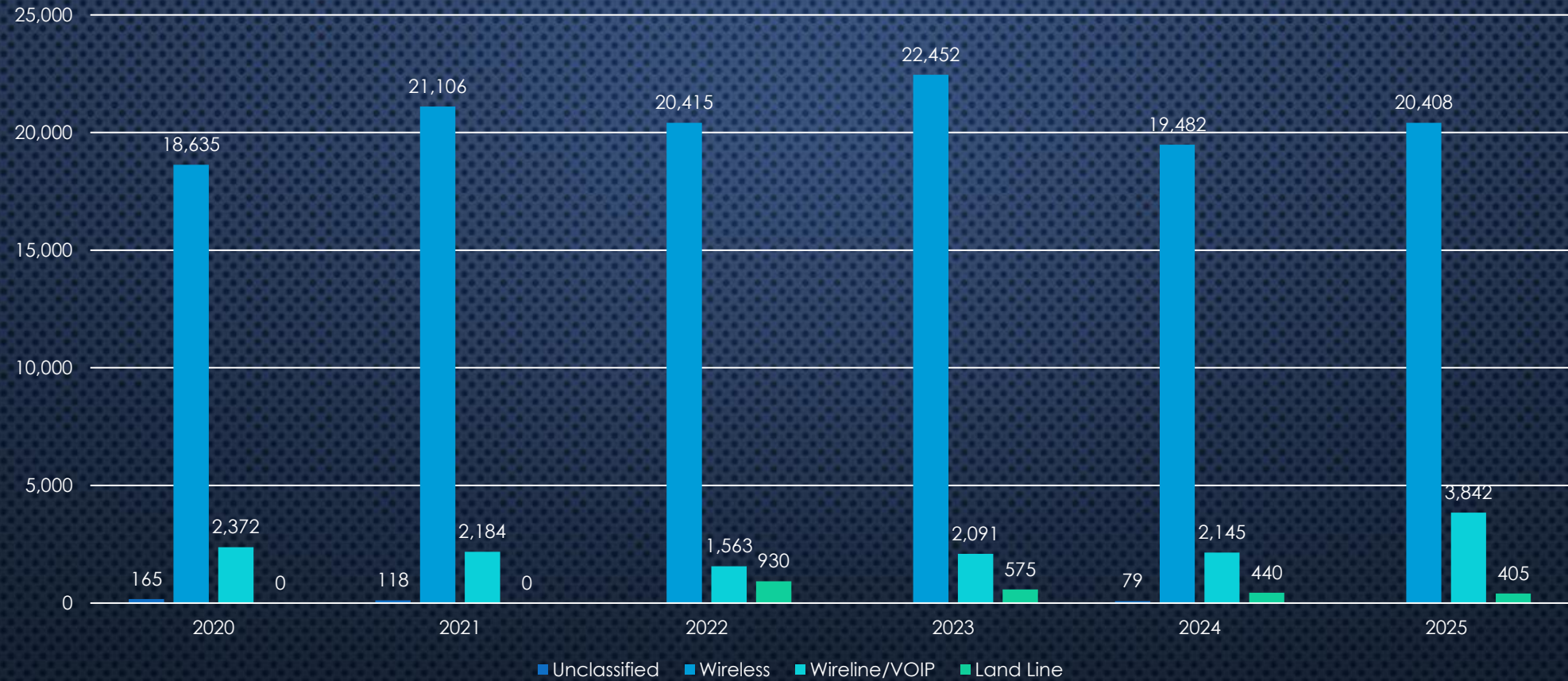
9-1-1 Calls by Hour of Day - 2025



911 CALLS BY TIME-OF-DAY 2025



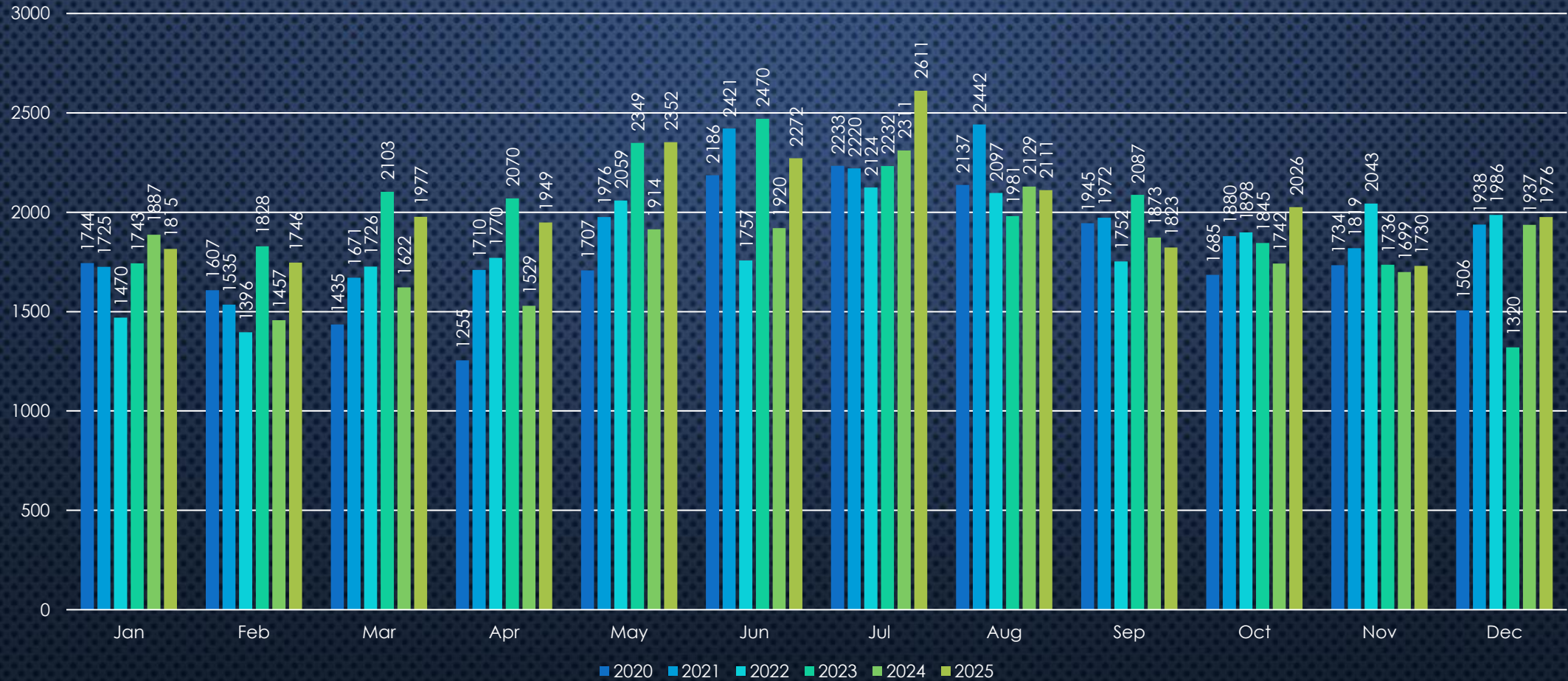
9-1-1 Calls by Class of Service 2020 - 2025



911 CALLS BY CLASS OF SERVICE



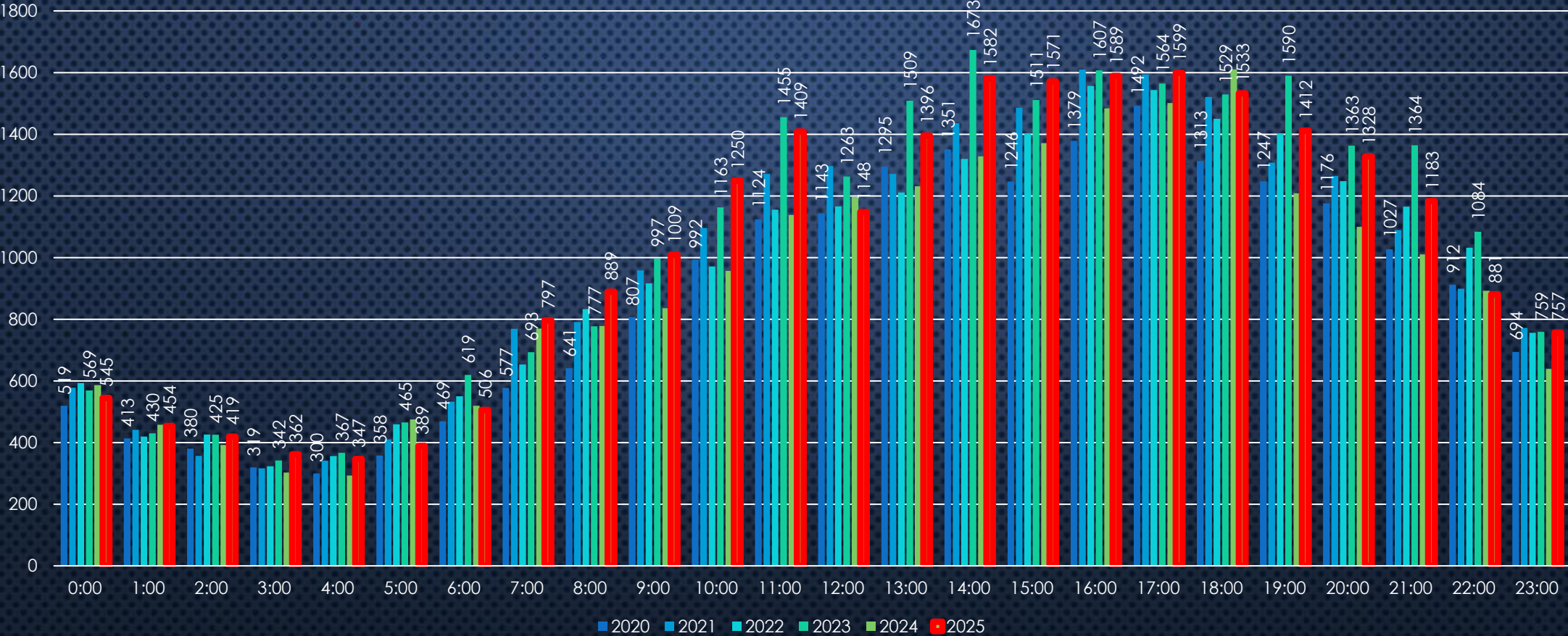
9-1-1 Calls by Month/Year 2020 - 2025

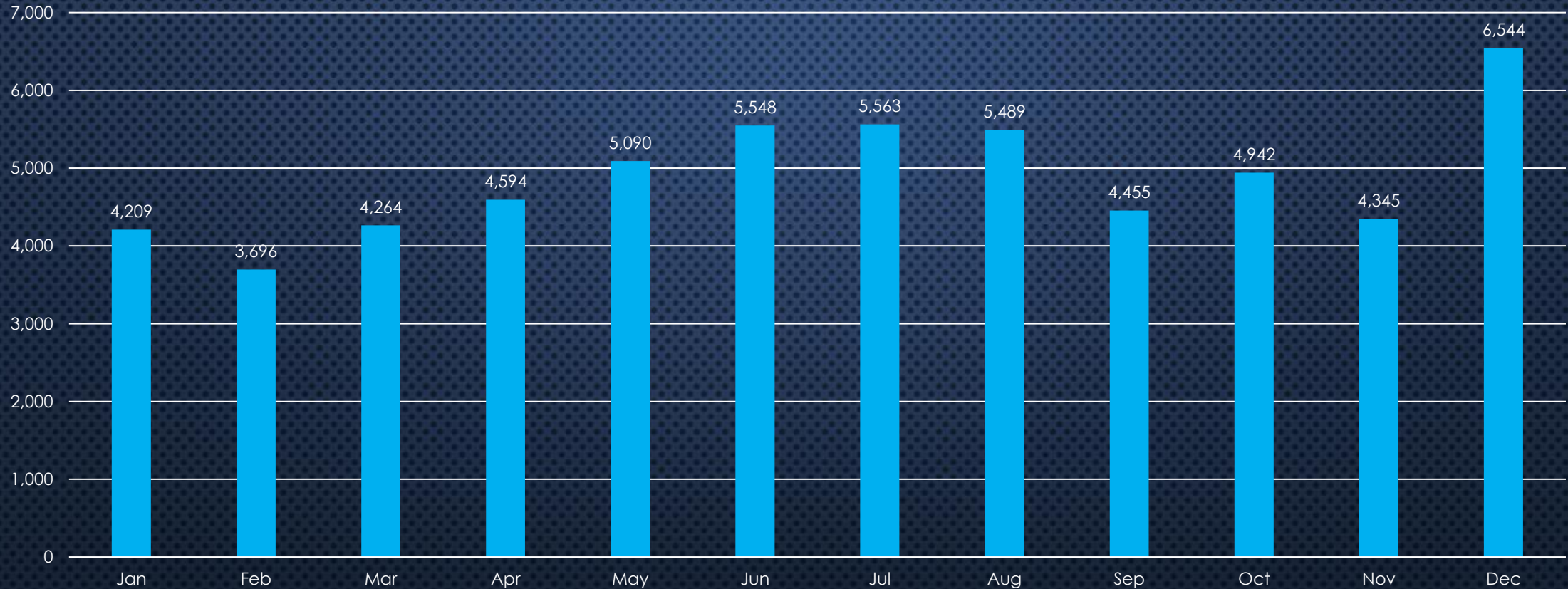
9-1-1 Calls by Time of Day / Years 2020 - 2025

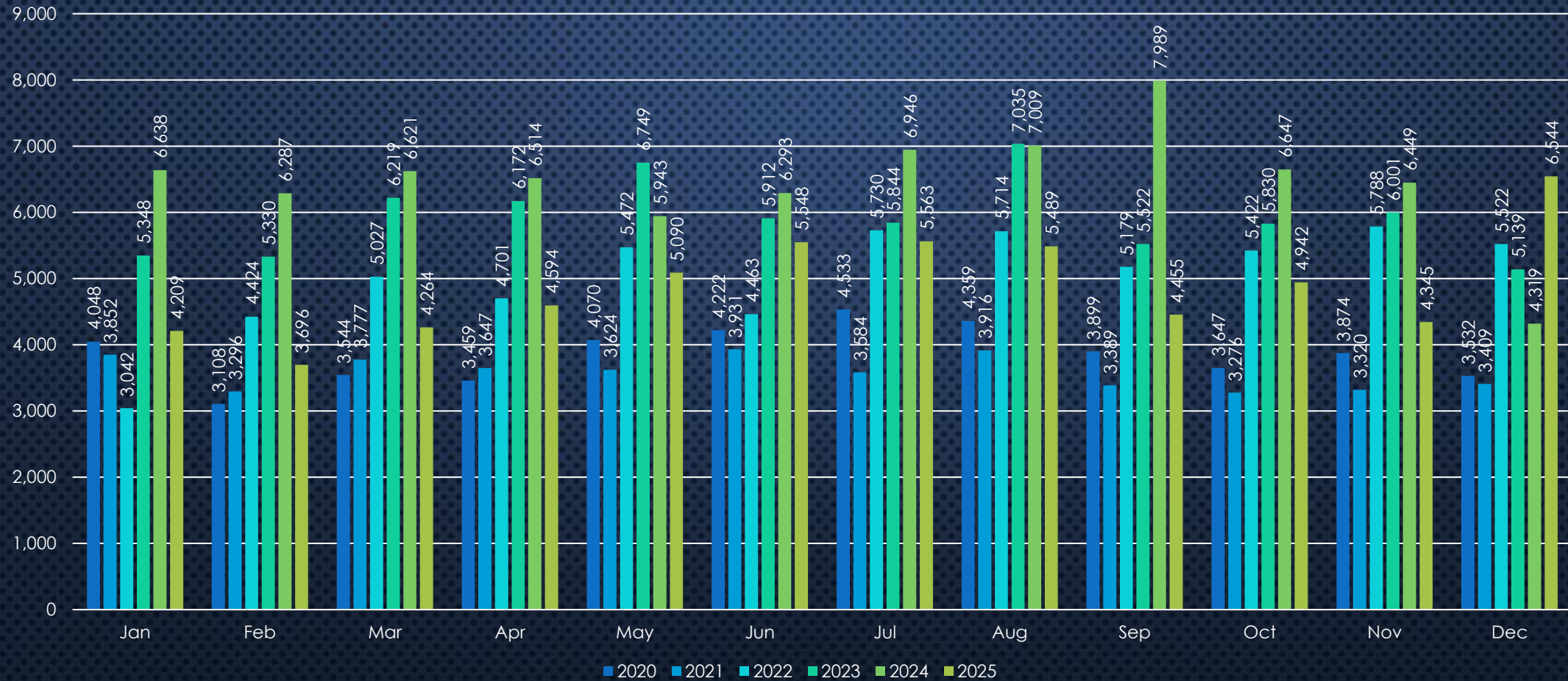
Non-Emergent/Admin Calls by Month 2025



NON-EMERGENT/ADMIN CALLS BY MONTH 2025



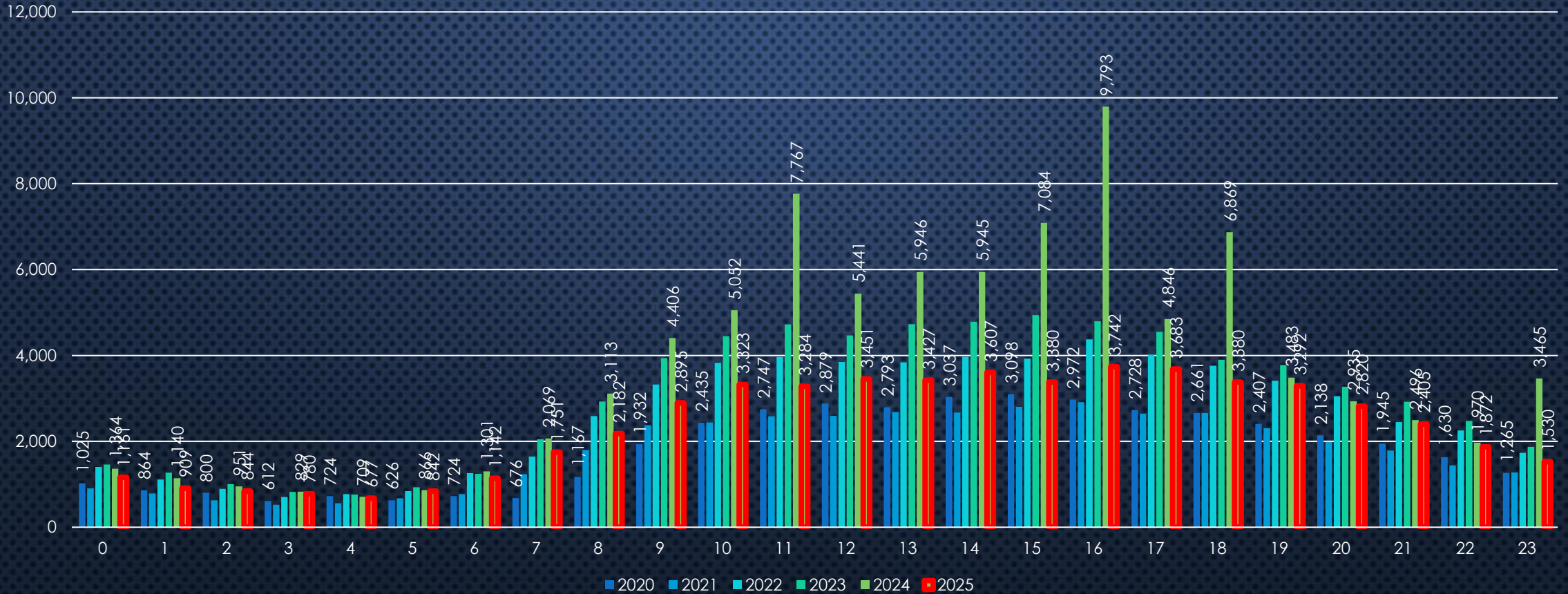
Non-Emergent/Admin Calls by Month/Year 2020 - 2025

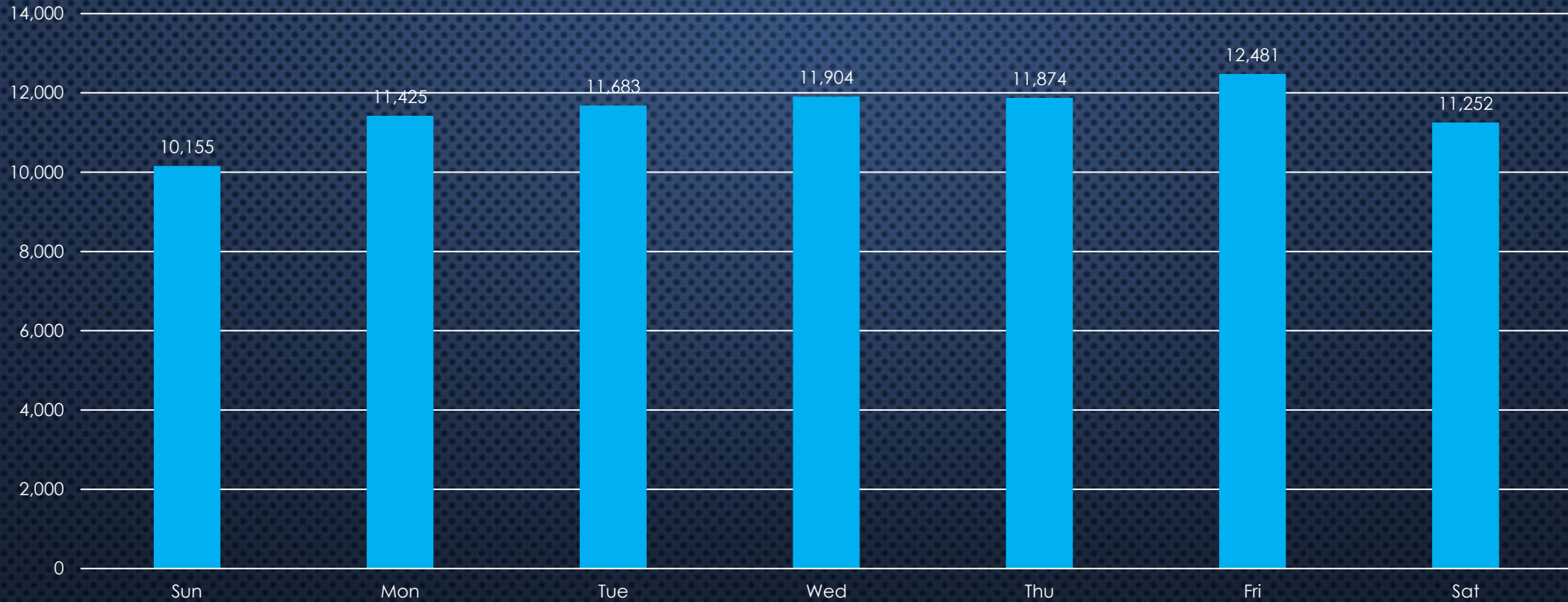
Non-Emergent/Admin Calls Time of Day/Year 2020 - 2025

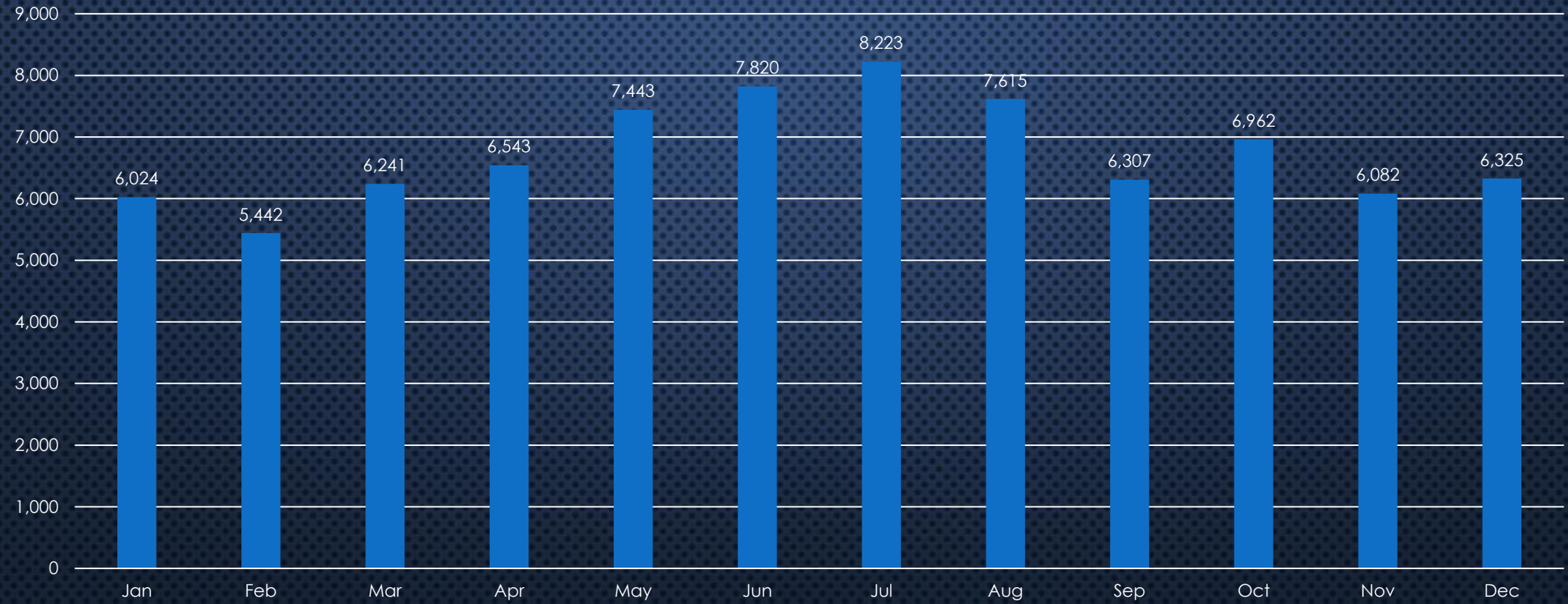
All Call by Day of Week 2025



ALL CALLS BY DAY OF WEEK 2025



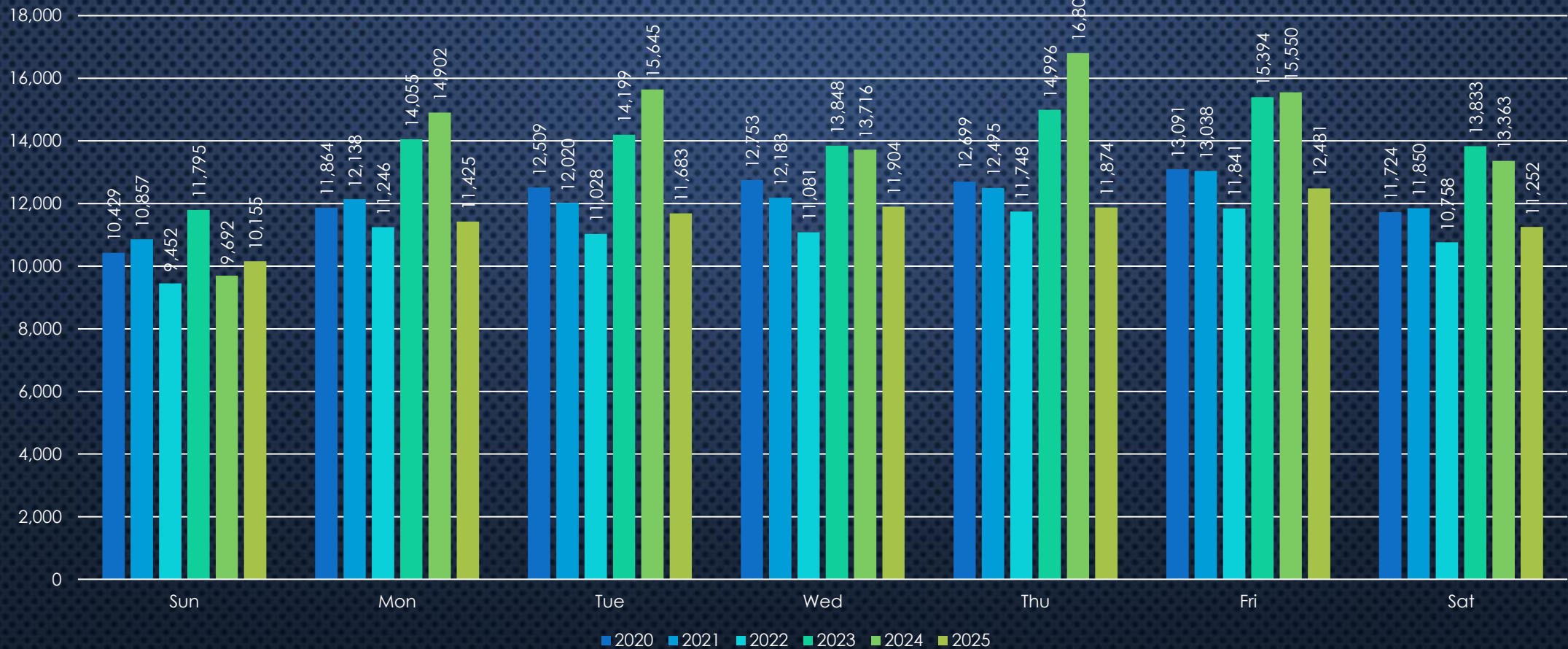
All Telephone Calls by Month 2025

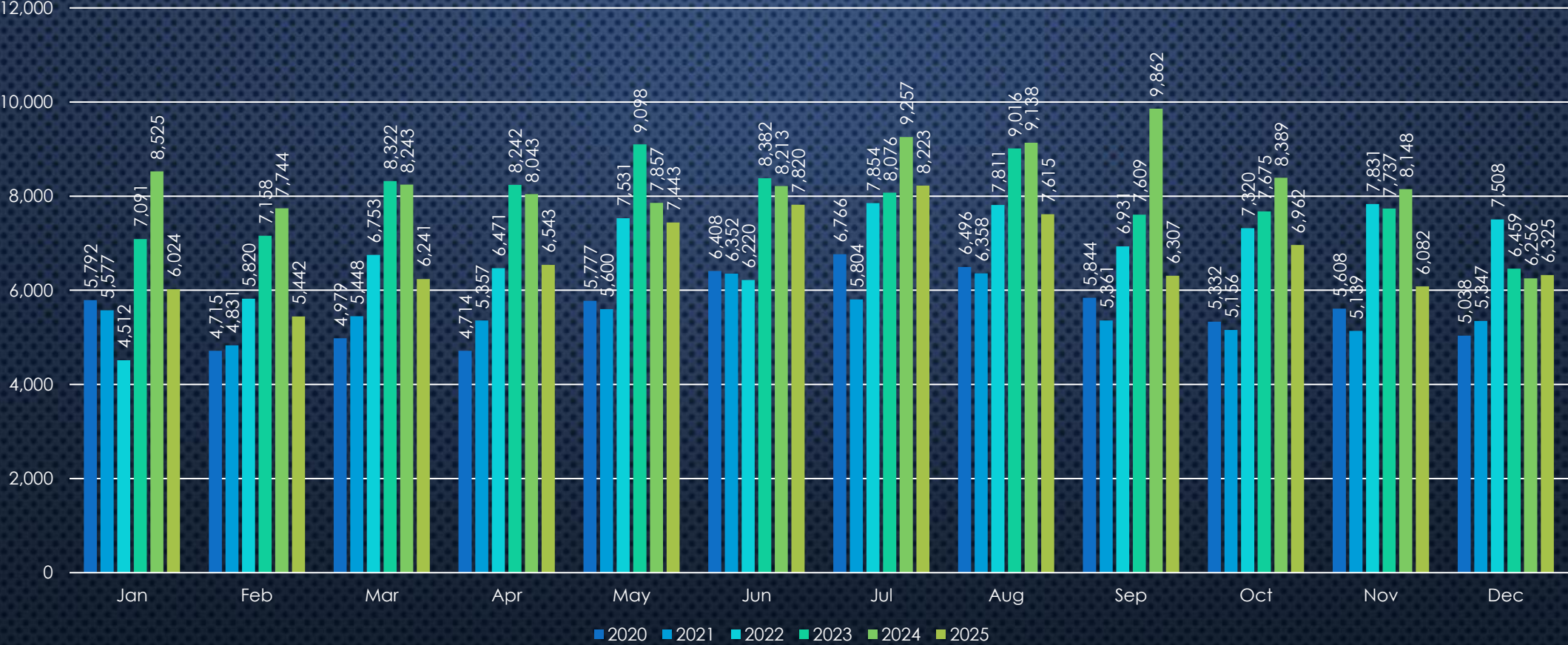
All Calls by Day of Week/Year 2020 - 2025

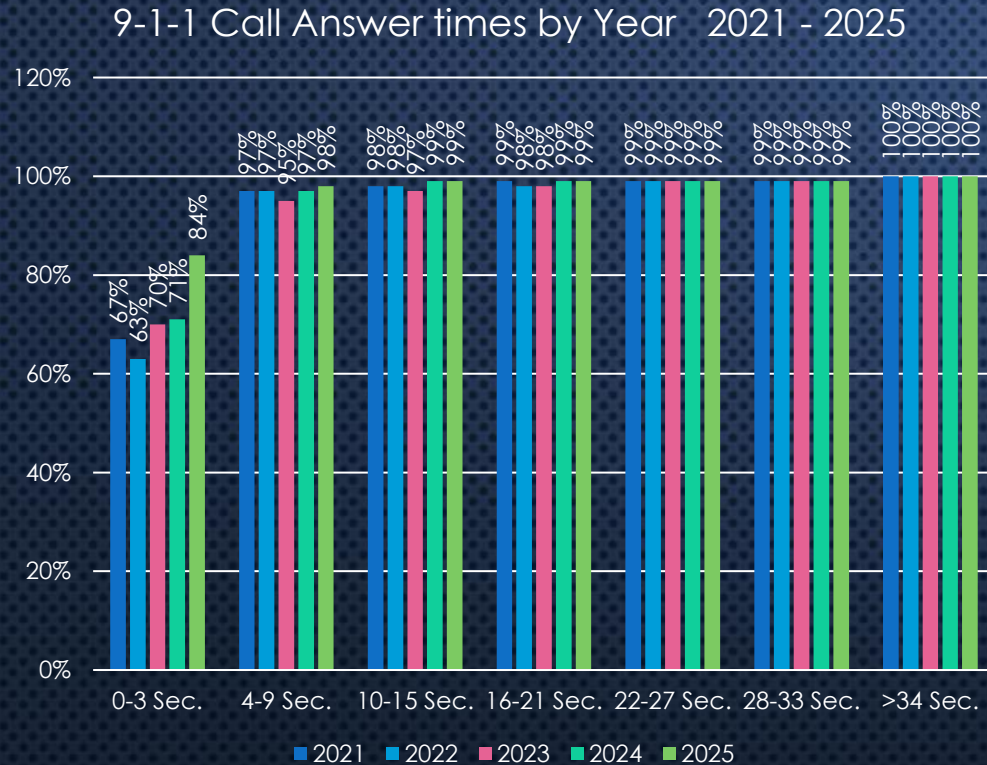

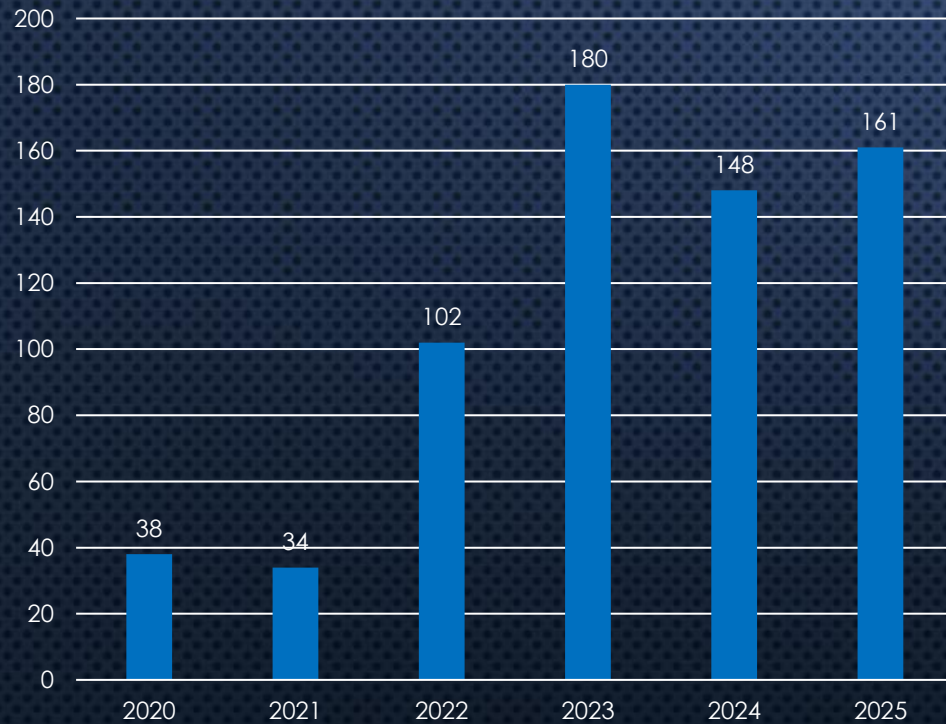
ICCD exceeds the standards with **95%** of the calls being answered in under 10 seconds.

- Time is calculated from when the 911 call is made and it hits the ESRP (Emergency Services Routing Proxy) until the Dispatcher answers the call.
- A normal rings heard by caller is about 6 seconds on their telephones.

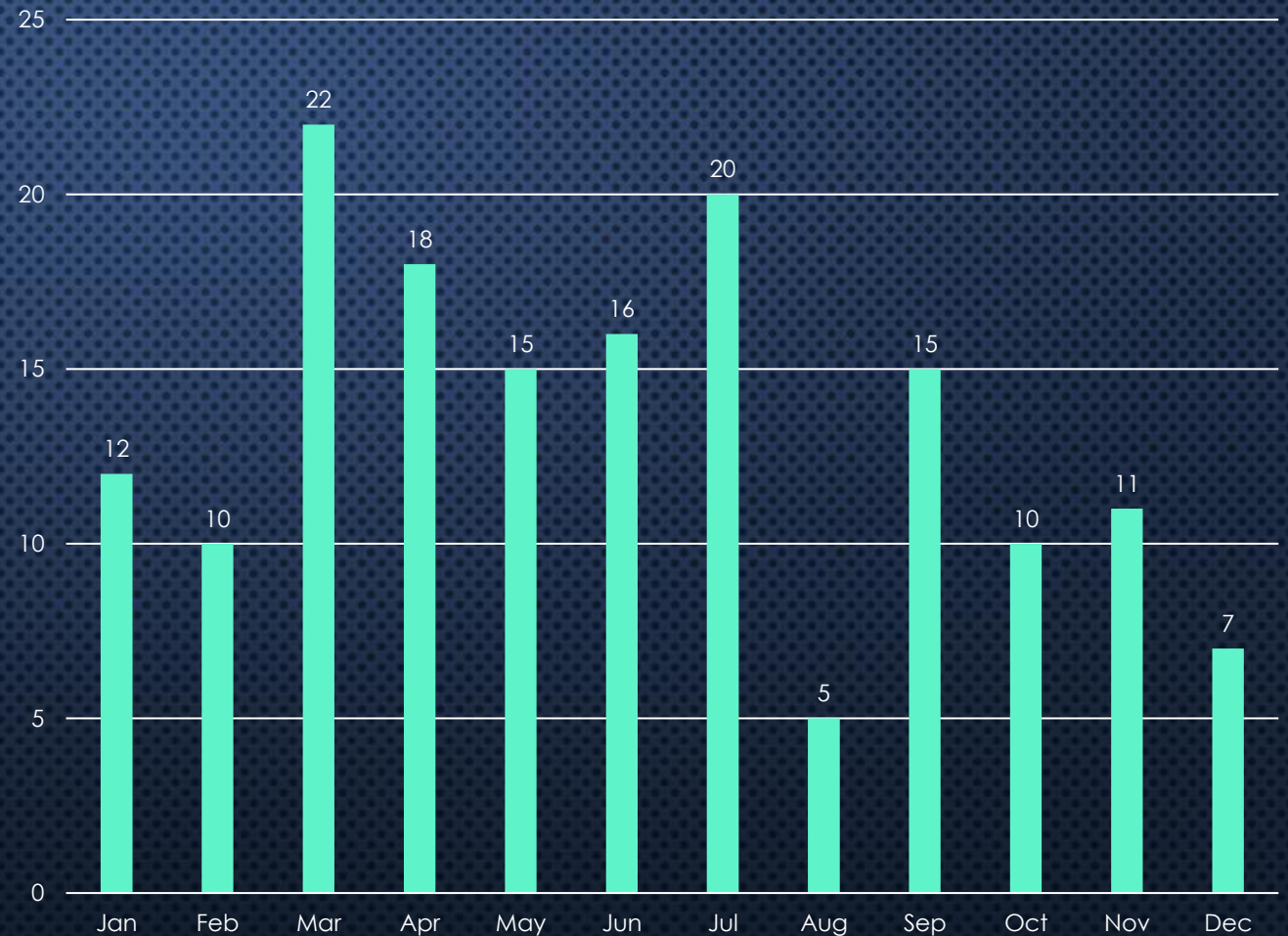

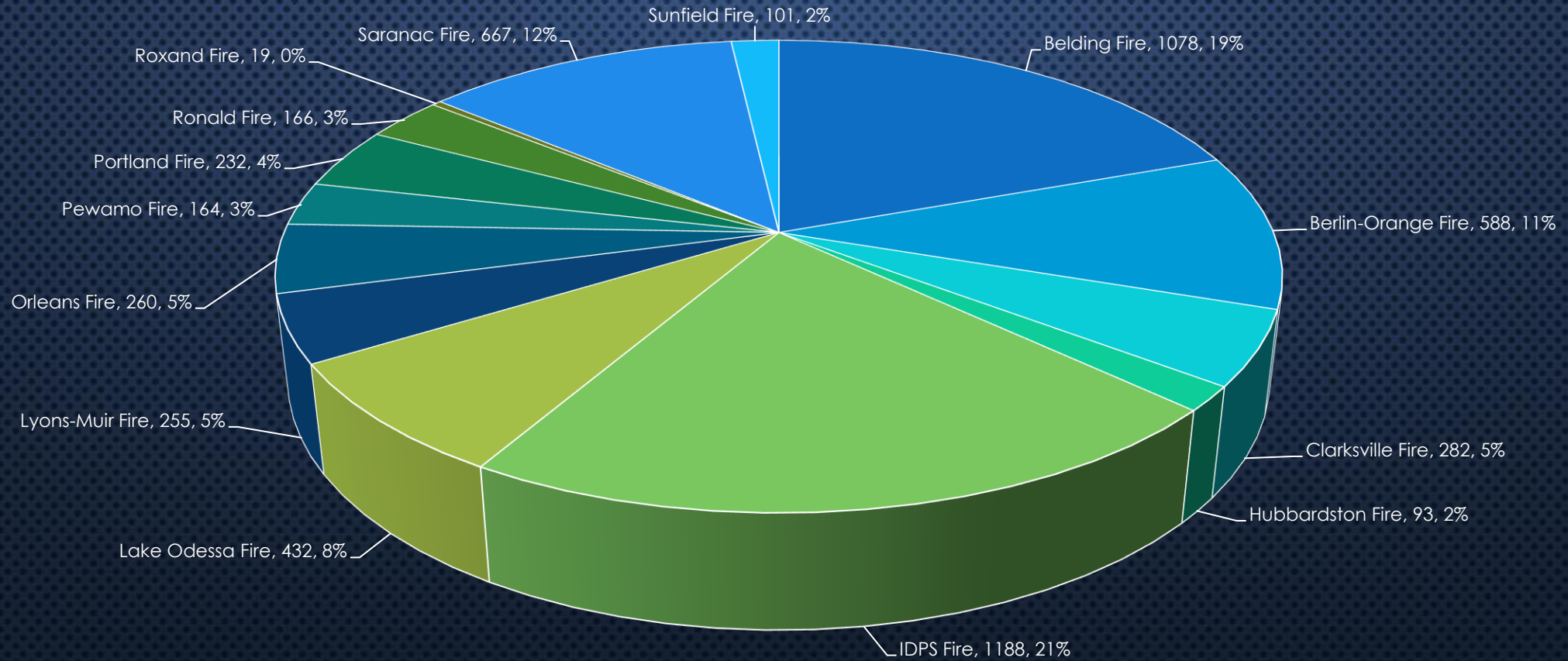

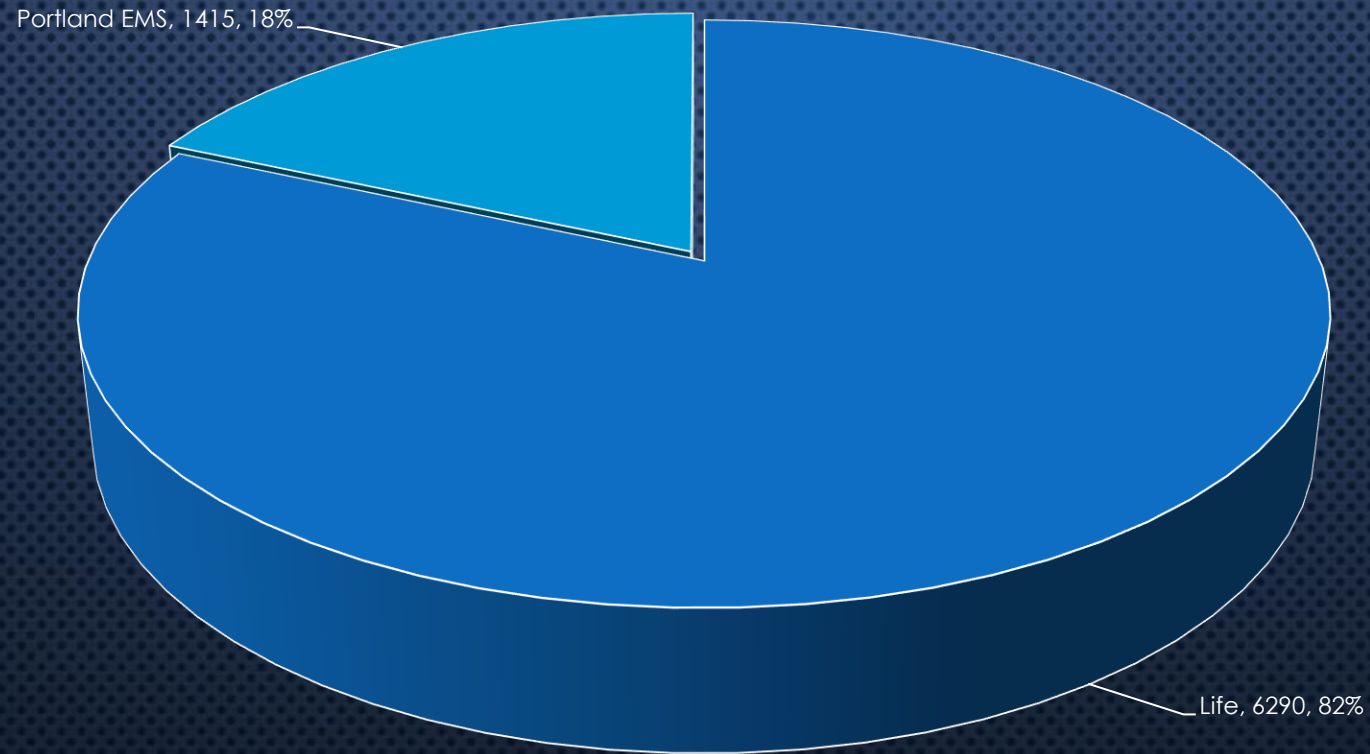
Fire CFS 2025 By Agency and Percentage of Total

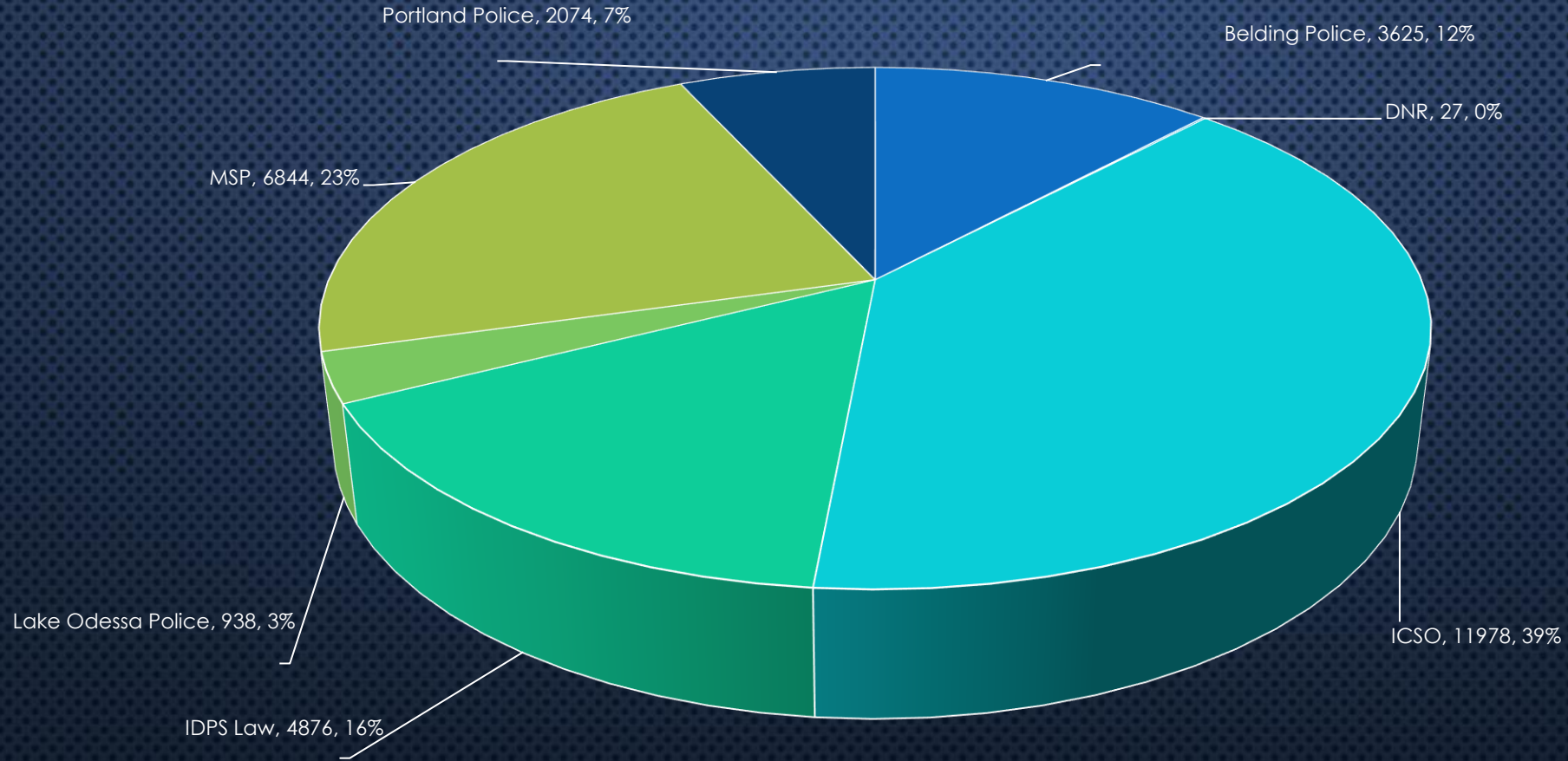
EMS CFS 2025 By Agency and Percentage of Total

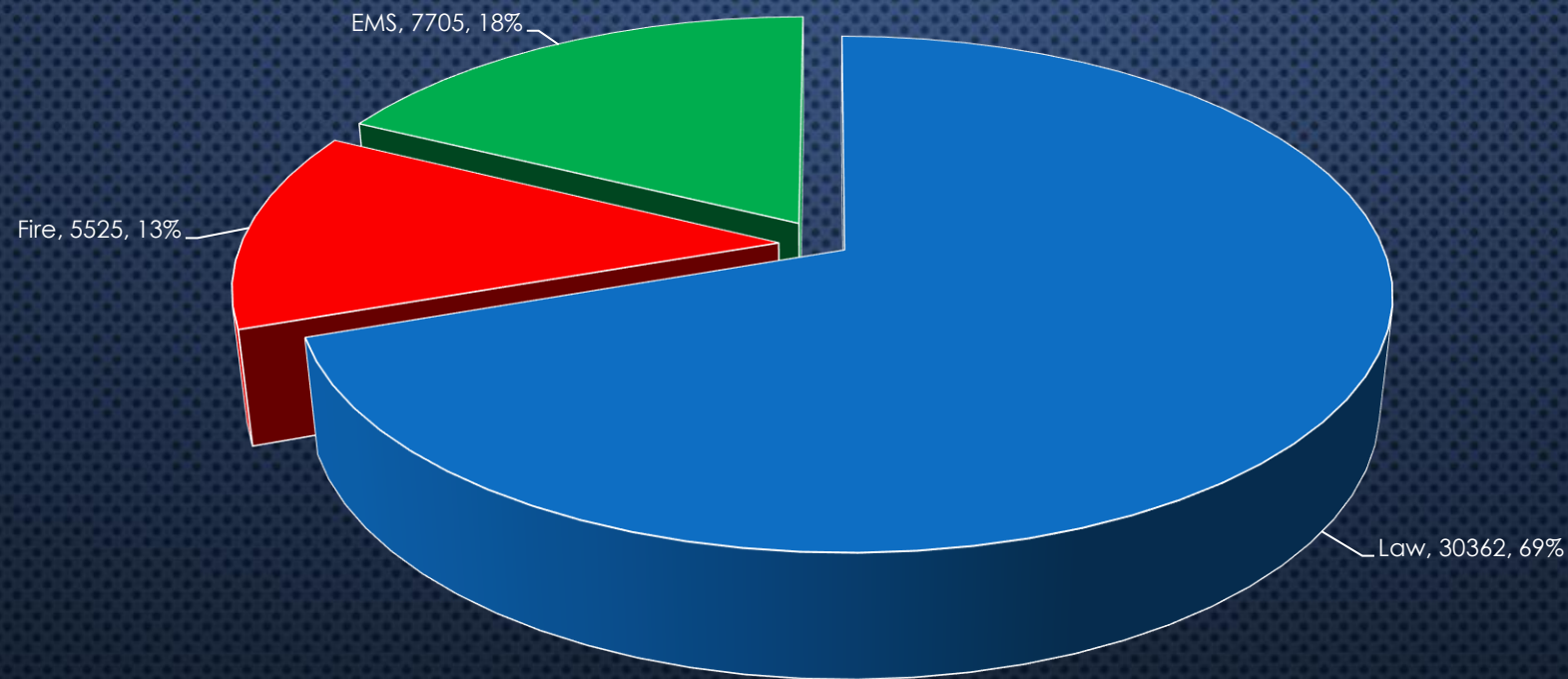
Law Enforcement CFS 2025 By Agency and Percentage of Total

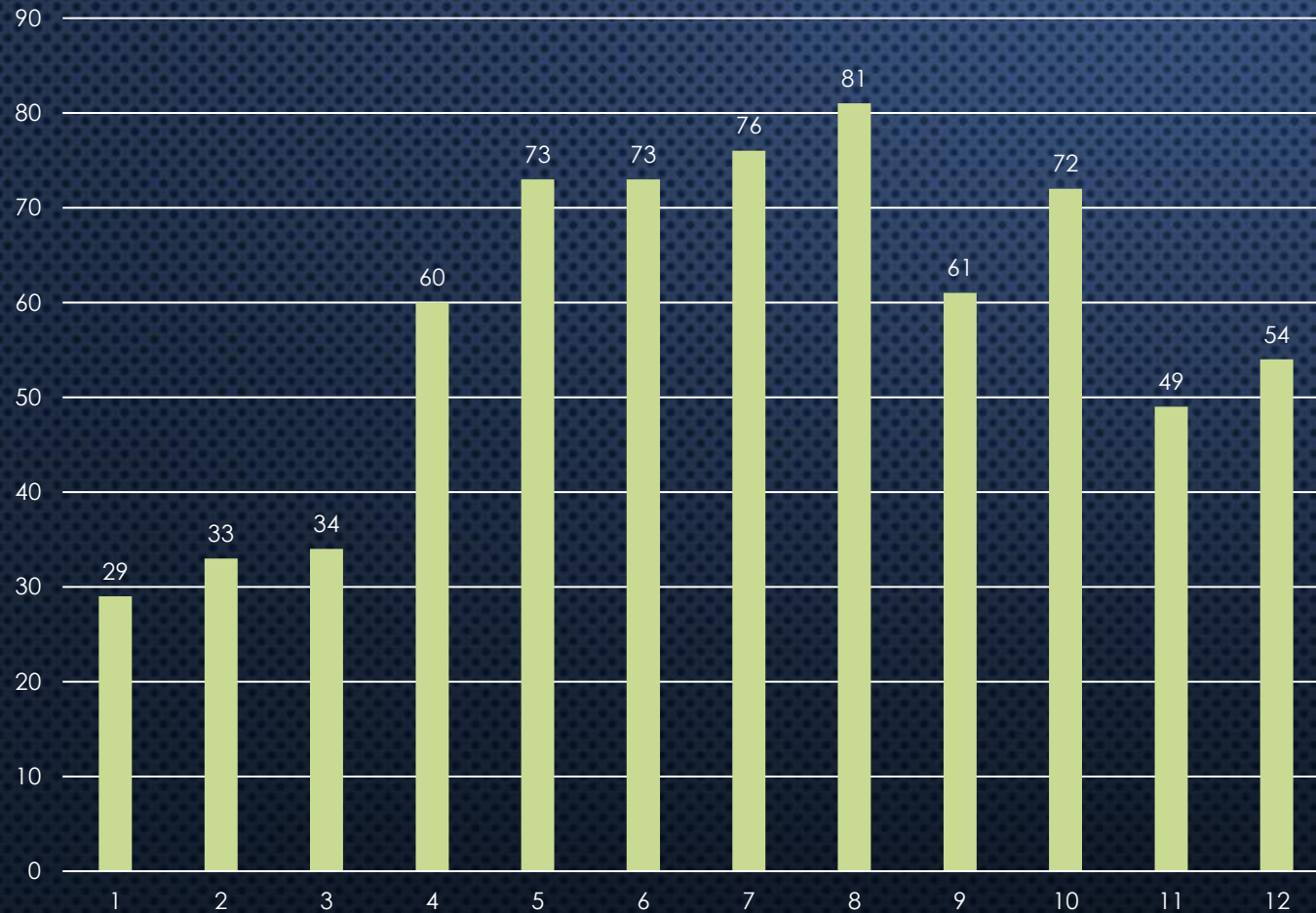
SERVICE TYPE - PERCENTAGE OF CALLS FOR SERVICE
