Michigan AG Use Exemption Qualifications for Building Permit

To qualify for agricultural use exemption from building permit requirements in Michigan, the following criteria must be met:

- The structure must be used solely for agricultural purposes and not for retail trade.
- The structure must not be used for storage of items not directly related to agricultural operations.
- The structure must not be open to the public or used for residential purposes.
- The structure must not be used for any purpose other than agricultural purposes, which would require compliance with the Michigan Building Code.

These qualifications ensure that agricultural structures remain dedicated to their intended use and do not infringe on zoning regulations or safety codes. It is essential for property owners to understand these qualifications to avoid potential legal issues and ensure compliance with local and state regulations.
