The Ionia County Drain Commissioner will hold a Day of Review of Drainage District Boundaries and Apportionments on the above date, time, and location. The Day of Review is an opportunity to review the Ginnebaugh Drain Drainage District boundaries and the tentative apportionment of benefits for each parcel and municipality within the Drainage District with the Drain Commissioner or staff member. The following is a list of any county, township, city, or village to be assessed: Ionia County and Danby Township.

At the Day of Review:

- No appointment is necessary.
- The Drain Commissioner, engineers and/or other staff members will be available to assist individuals and make revisions where necessary.
- The computation of costs for the Drain will be available.

Persons with disabilities needing accommodations for effective participation in the Day of Review should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at the number noted above (voice) or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the Day of Review to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance.

Assessments & Appeals

Drain assessments are collected in the same manner as property taxes and will appear on your winter tax bill. If drain assessments are being collected for more than one (1) year, you may pay the assessment in full with any interest to date at any time and avoid further interest charges.

You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's decision to revise the district boundary to the Ionia County Circuit Court within ten (10) days. You may appeal the Drain Commissioner's determination of apportionments to the Ionia County Probate Court within ten (10) days.
