Title: Contract for GPS Units & Cameras
Date: September 9, 2025

CONTACT: Linda Pigue, Road Dept. Managing Director; Tnnaer Roe, Road Supervisor & David Poff, Permit Agent

DESCRIPTION:

The Road Department's existing vehicle GPS system is outdated and does not have enough licenses for our fleet and must be replaced. We have consulted with several other County Road Commissions and want to leverage their experience with Samsara. We would like to contract for: 70 Gateway GPS units, 10 Air tags, and 25 road facing cameras. The road facing cameras will be placed in 2 Road Supervisor trucks, 5 lead worker trucks, 1 on-call truck; 13 A Team trucks, 1 motor grader, and 3 additional trucks.

The 70 Gateway units and 10 Air tags will cost \$17,379.60/year. The 25 road facing cameras will cost \$8,700/year. The \$26,079.60 annual cost is included in the Road department's budget.

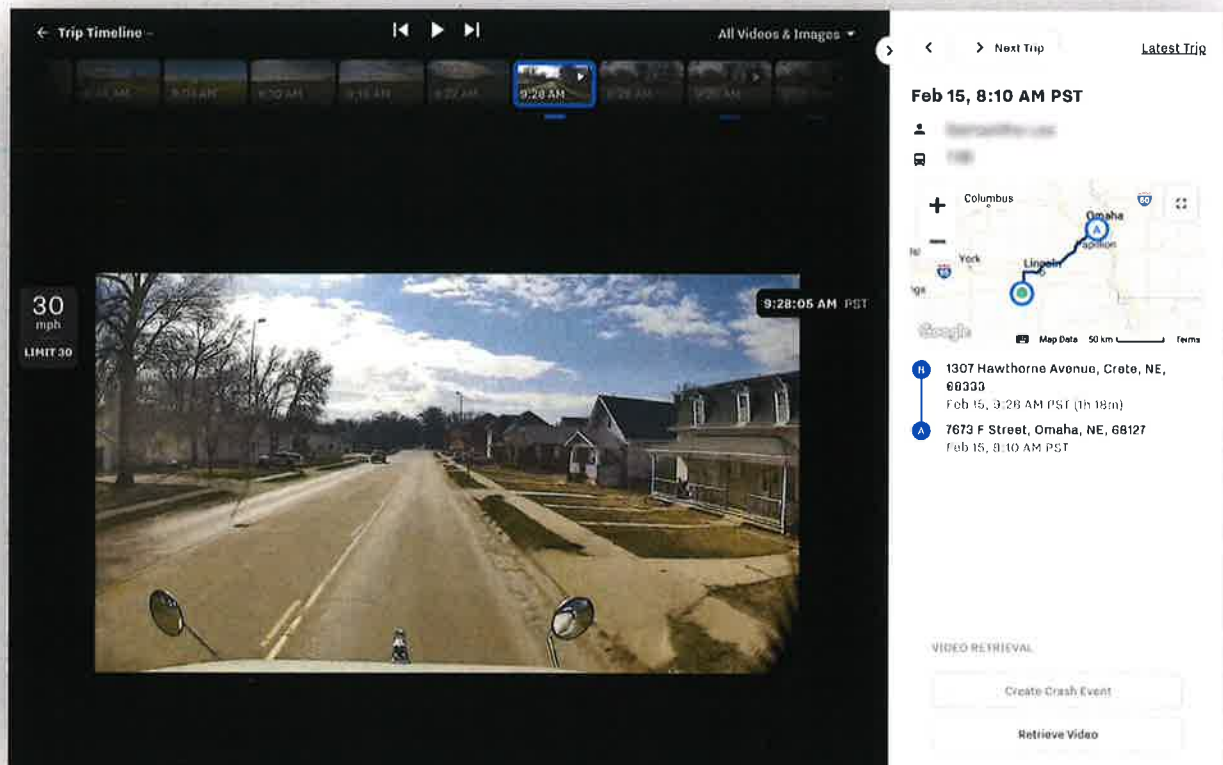

Dear Commissioners,

This letter explains why two estimates are submitted instead of the requested three for the replacement of the shop service truck for the Road Department. The requirement for multiple estimates is understood, and a diligent effort was made to obtain them. However, the following circumstances were encountered: Multiple vendors were contacted, but only BEC BROWN EQUIPMENT and MTECH COMPANY responded to the request for the completed quote. A significant amount of time was spent with a third vendor, VIKING CHIVES that resulted in many unreturned phone calls and a no-show scheduled appointment to review specifications that we have already been working on.

My goal is to get our current service truck "which will soon be 24 years old" replaced with the new service truck that we have in the budget for 2025 before this year's winter season begins, and I believe obtaining additional estimates might be counterproductive. The available quotes from BEC BROWN EQUIPMENT and MTECH COMPANY are attached for review. My recommendation would be for BEC BROWN EQUIPMENT for two reasons. First, they have the better price, and second, this truck is already available and will meet our specifications and can be delivered within a two week period after board approval for purchase.

THERE ARE NO UNDERSTANDINGS, TERMS, CONDITIONS OF WARRANTIES NOT FULLY EXPRESSED HEREIN.
2. **LIMITED WARRANTIES.** Seller warrants that it can convey good title to the goods sold under this contract and that they are free of liens and encumbrances. Warranties are per manufacturer's written warranty or unless specified. Seller's total cumulative liability in any way arising from or pertaining to any product sold or required to be sold under this contract shall NOT in any case exceed the purchase price paid by Buyer for such products. IN NO EVENT SHALL SELLER HAVE ANY LIABILITY FOR COMMERCIAL LOSS, LOST PROFITS, CLAIMS FOR LABOR, OR CONSEQUENTIAL OR INCIDENTAL DAMAGES OF ANY TYPE, WHETHER BUYER'S CLAIM BE BASED IN CONTRACT, TORT, WARRANTY, STRICT LIABILITY, NEGLIGENCE, OR OTHERWISE. 5. **FORCE MAJEURE.** In any event and in addition to all other limitations stated herein, Seller shall not be liable for any act, omission, result or consequence, including but not limited to any delay in delivery or performance, which is (i) due to any act of God, the performance of any government order, any order bearing priority rating or order placed under any allocation program (mandatory or voluntary) established pursuant to law, local labor shortage, fire, flood or other casualty, governmental regulation or requirement, shortage or failure of raw material, supply, fuel, power or transportation, breakdown of equipment, or any cause beyond Seller's reasonable control whether of similar or dissimilar nature to those above enumerated, or (ii) due to any strike, labor dispute, or difference with workers, regardless of whether or not Seller's is capable of settling any such labor problem.

9. **TRANSPORTATION CHARGES.** Delivered prices or prices involving competitive transportation adjustments shall be subject to appropriate adjustment to reflect changes in transportation charges.
10. **CLAIMS BY BUYER.** Buyer shall thoroughly inspect products sold under this contract immediately upon receipt to verify for itself that they conform to the specifications of the contract. Buyer must notify Seller of claims for failure or delay in delivery within 30 days after the scheduled delivery date. Buyer must notify Seller of any claims for nonconforming or defective goods within 30 days after the nonconformity or defect was or should have been discovered. In addition, Seller must be given an opportunity to investigate the claim before Buyer disposes of the material, or else Buyer's claim will be barred. Seller shall incur no liability for damage, shortages, or other cause alleged to have occurred or existed at or prior to delivery to the carrier unless the Buyer shall have entered full details thereof on its receipt to the carrier.

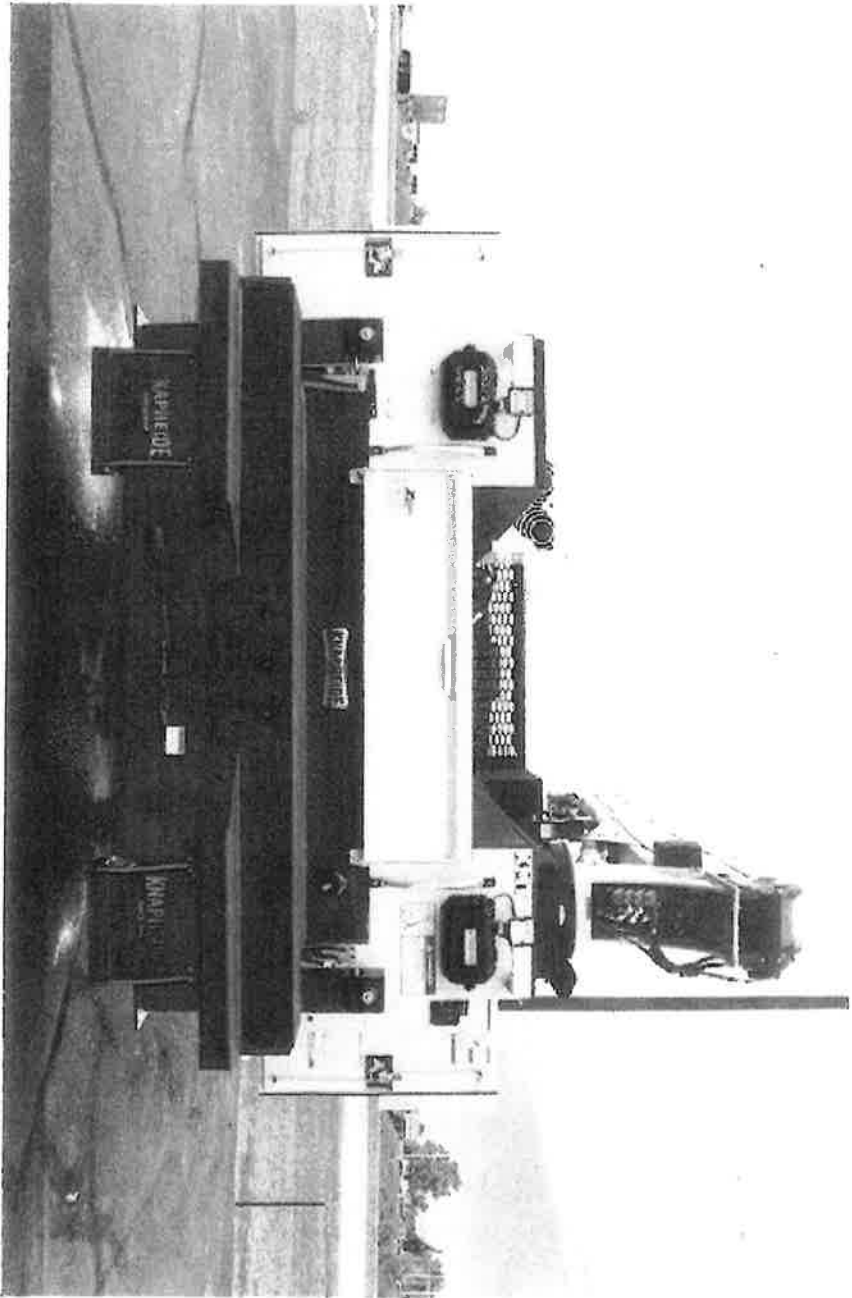

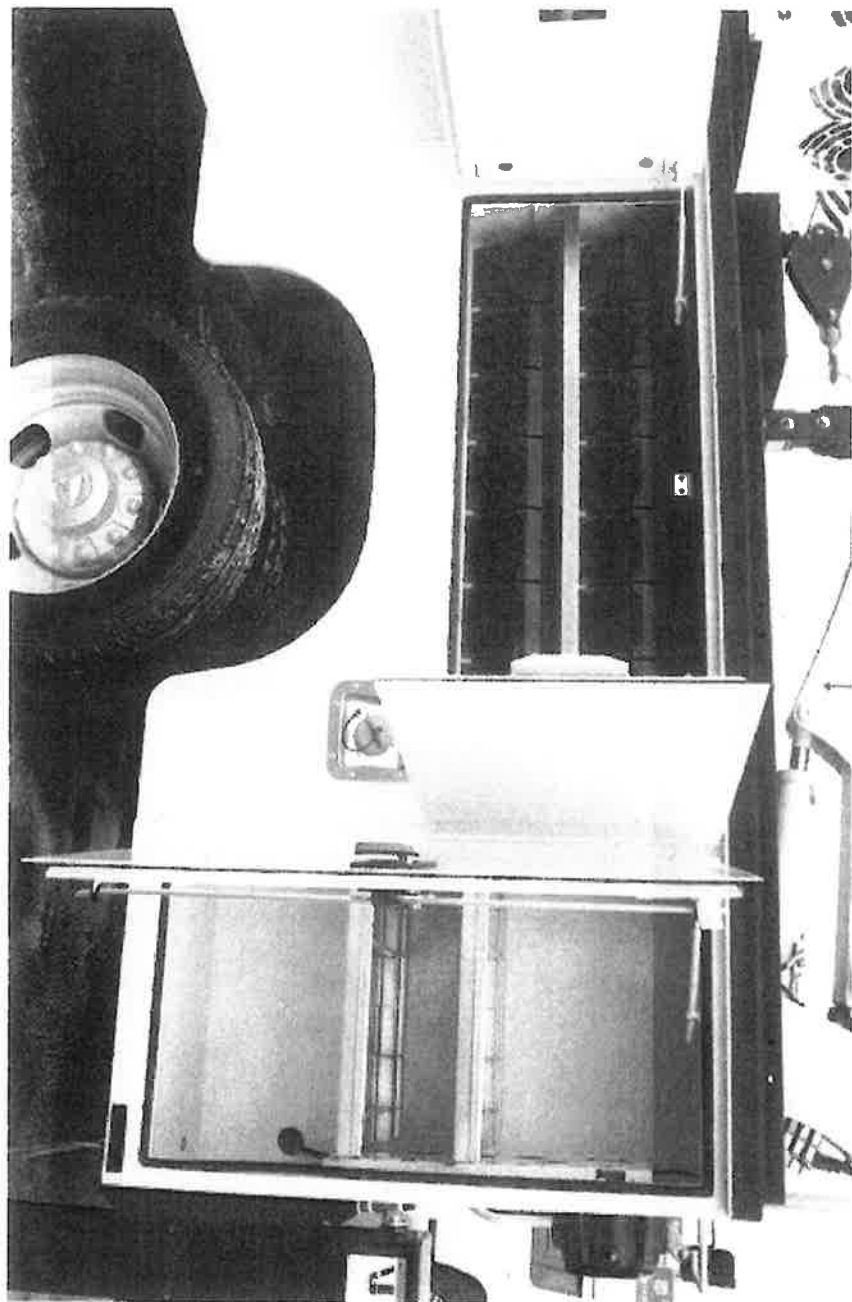

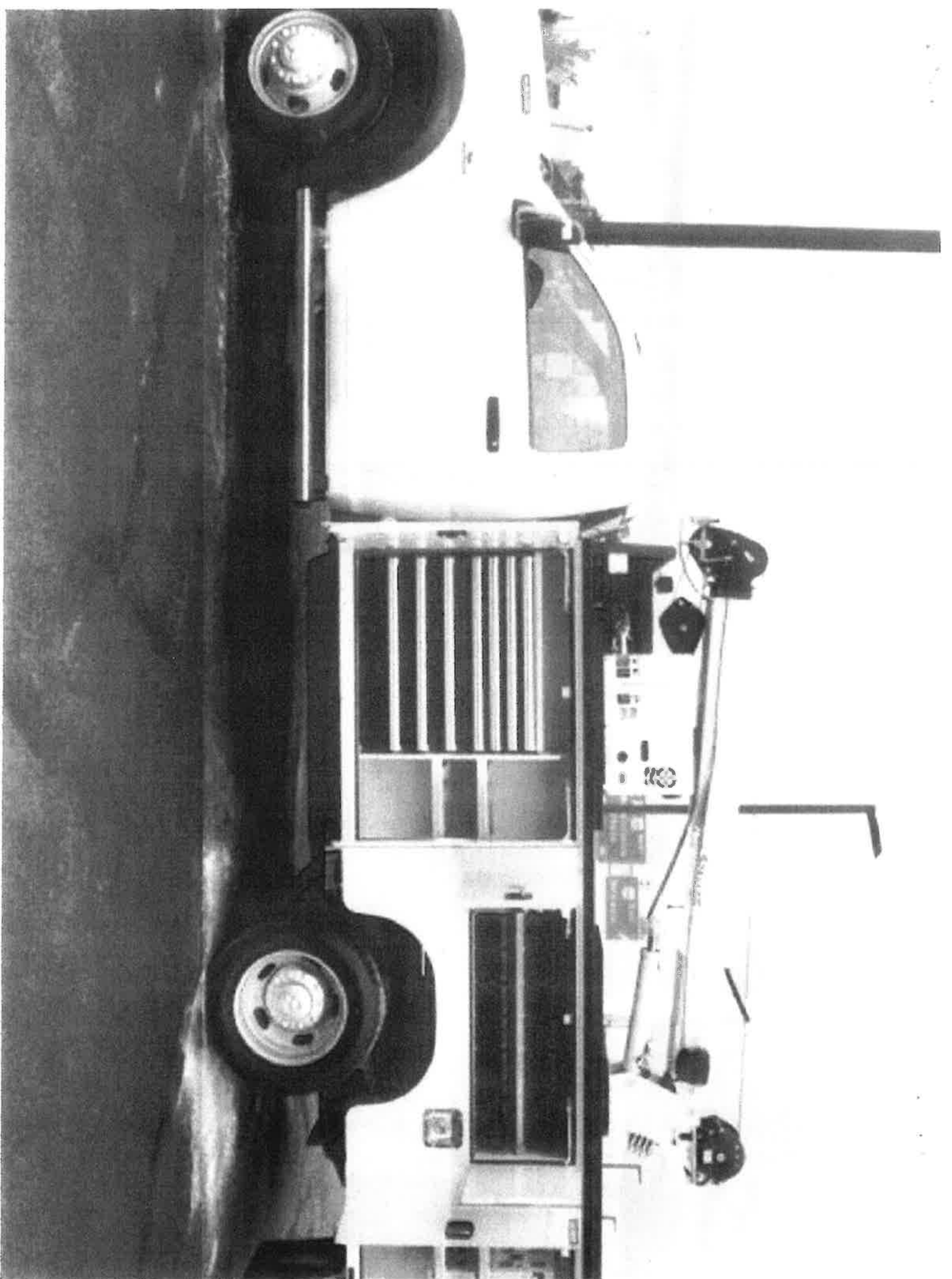

DESCRIPTION:

The Road Department's Policy 03 currently states that the cost of upgrading Primary Roads from gravel to pavement will be 25% funded by the Road Department from any source. It also states that the cost of Primary Road Bridge preservation, rehabilitation and replacement will be shared equally by the Road Department and the pertinent township. This includes bridge projects which include State and Federal funds. Costs include all engineering, permitting, right-of-way expenses, etc. The Road Department is requesting the reference to 25% from any source be eliminated. The Road Department is also requesting the policy be revised to eliminate the requirement of 50% of township funds. The revision is requested to assure that the work needed on Primary Road Bridges is not prevented due to lack of township funds.

FINANCIAL ANALYSIS:

Ionia County has 33 Primary Road Bridges and 34 Local Road Bridges. As of October 2024, the cost of repairing Primary Road Bridges was \$457,300. In addition, the Road Department was awarded Federal funds to replace the Borden Road Bridge over Prairie Creek, the costs not covered by the Federal funds is estimated to be \$304,000.

Our grant year is coming to an end at the end of this month. We are on track to end the year within our budgetary provisions from MIDC. Our new grant year begins October 1st, and we are thankful for another year of full funding and resources to provide quality legal representation to the indigent defendants of our county.

We are proud to be celebrating our 7th Anniversary for the Ionia County Public Defender Office. Our office was created and opened at the beginning of September, 2018. We began to appear for every arraignment held in District and Circuit Court on October 1, 2018, and have for the past seven years. We have been appointed and opened 5.427 client cases over that time period.

Summer and fall vacation and training schedules make it a challenge to ever feel we are fully staffed on any given day. But we are making it through juggling and covering for each other. Caseloads are staying at a consistent and normal level for the past few months, which helps in our ability to properly handle client's cases.

Our three fall interns began in our office the week of August 25th. For the first time all three interns - Emma Compton, Sophia Doukas, and Olivia Dobrzycki - come from the same school. All three are Michigan State undergraduates with plans to attend law school after their graduations. Our interns are an important part of our team in the office assisting our paralegals, and coming along with our attorneys to court hearings to observe and learn. We continue to be able to lock in intern commitments several semesters in advance for their internship opportunity in our office, with usually a waitlist for each semester in case an opening should happen.

We have several cases headed to jury trial in the Circuit and District Courts in the coming months, so it continues to be a very busy time for us in the office. Jury Selections in Circuit Court are scheduled for October 8 and 15, with those trials scheduled in the subsequent three months after selections. So we will have a very full fall schedule of jury trials ahead for our office.
