

# Bertha Brock Park Rules and Regulations

## Basic Park Rules

1. Park hours for day use is 8:00 am – Dusk
2. The speed limit within the park is 15 miles per hour
3. **NO** motorized vehicles, bicycles, or horses will be allowed off the road network inside the boundaries of this park.
4. Camping is allowed **ONLY** by permit. No day use in the campground
5. **NO** hunting is allowed within this park at any time.
6. All State of Michigan and Federal laws apply for guns within the park. Discharge of firearms is unlawful.
7. Dog **MUST** be leashed at ALL times and cleaned up after.
8. **NO** animals can be left unattended, including being locked in a tent, car, or camper.
9. Small fires may be built only in stoves, fireplaces, and fire rings when camping.
10. Persons apprehended for damaging buildings, signs, trees, shrubs, or other park property, or for reckless driving, will be prosecuted.
11. No person shall sell any merchandise without a written permit.
12. Place all trash in the barrels provided. Your cooperation is solicited to help us keep the park clean. Littering fines will be issued for excessive cleanup.
13. **NO** Fireworks, confetti, or glitter at any time
14. **Smoking Marijuana is prohibited in the park**
15. No loud music
16. Persons using this park must respect the rights of others.
17. Take nothing but pictures, leave nothing but footprints.

## Pavilion Rentals:

1. Reservations are good from 8:00 am to DUSK.
2. There are **NO** rain dates or refunds for any natural occurrences (ie: mosquitoes)
3. The following items are **NOT PERMITTED**:
  - Nails
  - Staples
  - Confetti
  - Glitter
  - Pinatas,
  - Raw Eggs
  - Sawdust
  - Silly sting
  - Paints
  - Water balloons
4. Park visitors are reminded that food is litter; as such please be sure to place food in the trash barrels provided.
5. You may move the tables if needed; however, you **MUST** return the tables to their original position.
6. It is expected that you will clean the pavilion after your rental and return it to the condition in which it was found. Charcoal grill coals can remain; we will clean them after they cool.
7. Failure to comply with these rules **WILL** result in the assessment of cleaning fees.
8. Please smoke in designated smoke areas/ **Marijuana is PROHIBITED**

## Camping:

1. Camping is first-come, first-served on numbered sites only
2. Two tents or recreational units and two cars **maximum** per site (per DEQ law)
3. Camping is allowed for up to 6 consecutive nights. After the 6<sup>th</sup> night, you must leave the campground for a minimum of 10 consecutive days, and if you choose to return to Bertha Brock Park Campground, you must rent a different site than the site previously rented.
4. **NO** animals can be left unattended, including being locked in a tent, car, or camper.
5. Check out or re-register by 1:00 pm.
6. Maximum 8 people per site.
7. Camping registration is located at the toll booth at the entrance of the park, along with the rules.
8. We offer ONLY “rustic” camping. There is NO water hookups or electricity.
9. Quiet time/visitors leave- 10:00 pm
10. **NO** fireworks allowed at any time.
11. If you pay, you must set up.

Park rules are posted at the entrance of the park. You and your guest are expected to abide by these rules during your rental. Please enjoy your visit!
