

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARINGS OF PRACTICABILITY AND ASSESSMENT

JORDAN LAKE IMPROVEMENT BOARD

TAKE NOTICE that public hearings of the Jordan Lake Improvement Board ("Board") will be held on **August 27, 2026 at 6:00pm**, at the **Odessa Township Hall, located at 3862 Laurel Drive, Lake Odessa, Michigan 48849**. The purpose of these public hearings is to: (1) consider the practicability of a continued lake improvement project that consists of aquatic plant control and other related activities intended to improve Jordan Lake ("lake improvement project"); and (2) to consider an assessment roll for the proposed lake improvement project. In summary, the Board is proposing three added years of annual special assessments at the same dollar amount as the last three years. More information and documents associated with the proposed lake improvement project such as an assessment roll will be available at the public hearings or upon request to the Office of the Barry County Drain Commissioner at 269-945-1385. **The proposed lake improvement project proposes annual special assessments for three additional years in approximate amounts of up to \$145.00 for lakefront parcels and \$95.00 for non-lakefront parcels (the same levels as the prior three years). The proposed special assessment roll also intends to specially assess local units of government at large as it has done historically being: (1) the Village of Lake Odessa; (2) Woodland Township; and (3) Odessa Township.**

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that pursuant to Part 309 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, the Jordan Lake Improvement Board will determine the practicability of continuing the lake improvement project and will review a corresponding special assessment roll for the project, hear any property owner objections to the lake improvement project and the proposed assessment roll, and make a determination of whether or not to confirm said assessment roll. The hearing may be adjourned from time-to-time without further notice.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that appearance and protest at the assessment hearing is required to appeal your special assessment. Property owners and those concerned may attend the public hearings and offer comment. Any person or entity objecting to the assessment roll may attend the public hearings **and/or** file their objection in writing with the Jordan Lake Improvement Board. Any such person or entity can file an appearance and protest by letter addressed to the **Jordan Lake Improvement Board at 220 W. State Street, Hastings, Michigan 49058**. Protest letters received by the Jordan Lake Improvement Board by no later than the assessment hearing shall be given the same effect as attendance and protest at the assessment hearing. The Jordan Lake Improvement Board shall maintain a record of parties who appear to protest at the hearings. If the hearings are terminated or adjourned before a party is provided the opportunity to be heard, a party whose appearance was recorded shall be considered to have protested the special assessment in person.

TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that the owner or any person having an interest in property within the district and having protested such special assessment may file a written appeal of their special assessment with the Michigan Tax Tribunal or other court of competent jurisdiction within thirty (30) days after published notice of confirmation of the special assessment roll. Please review MCL 211.746 and MCL 324.30913 regarding appeals.

Proceedings conducted at these public hearings will be subject to the provisions of the Michigan Open Meetings Act and you are further notified that information regarding this meeting may be obtained from the Barry County Drain Commissioner's Office at **269-945-1385**. Persons with disabilities or otherwise needing accommodations for effective participation in the meeting should contact the Drain Commissioner's Office at **269-945-1385** or through the Michigan Relay Center at 7-1-1 (TDD) at least 24 hours in advance of the meeting to request mobility, visual, hearing, or other assistance. Minutes of the meeting will be on file in the Barry County Drain Commissioner's Office.

FAQs

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS about the Notice of Public Hearings of Practicability and Assessment

Why am I receiving this notice?

You are receiving this notice because you may own lands within a Special Assessment District historically used to fund a lake improvement project for the purposes of aquatic plant control and other related activities intended to improve Jordan Lake ("Lake Improvement Project").

What is a special assessment district?

A special assessment district is an area of lands designated to receive special assessments for a particular benefit that they receive from certain lake improvements like aquatic plant control.

What are the public hearings about?

The Jordan Lake Improvement Board is considering the practicability of continuing the Lake Improvement Project. The Jordan Lake Improvement Board will also consider a proposed assessment roll associated with the Lake Improvement Project. The proposed special assessment roll would approve three additional years of special assessments at the same levels as the past three years (\$145.00 lakefront and \$95.00 for non-lakefront parcels).

Why are you holding two public hearings for these activities?

The statute that governs lake improvement board projects, Part 309 of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, requires two public hearings. Additionally, the Jordan Lake Improvement Board wants to be as transparent as possible and solicit any input from impacted property owners.

Do I have to attend the public hearings?

You are not required to attend the public hearings. However, you must protest in person or by writing to reserve your right to appeal the special assessment should you desire to.

When would I receive my special assessment?

If approved, assessments will appear on your winter tax bills beginning in 2026.
