LAKWOOD PUBLIC SCHOOLS
OPERATING MILLAGE PROPOSAL

This proposal will enable the school district to levy the statutory rate of 18 mills on all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, required for the school district to receive its revenue per pupil foundation allowance.

Shall the limitation on the amount of taxes which may be assessed against all property, except principal residence and other property exempted by law, in Lakewood public Schools, Ionia, Barry, Eaton and Kent Counties, Michigan, be increased by 1 mill (\$1.00 on each \$1000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 7 years, 2008 to 2014, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2008 is approximately \$0.00 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore the reduction)?
