(Haynor School), Ionia County, Michigan be increased by 2.6054 mills (\$2.6054 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation) for a period of 6 years, 2009 to 2014, inclusive, to provide funds for operating purposes; the estimate of the revenue the school district will collect if the millage is approved and levied in 2009 is approximately \$2,073 (this millage is to restore millage lost as a result of the reduction required by the Michigan Constitution of 1963 and will be levied only to the extent necessary to restore that reduction)?</i></p>

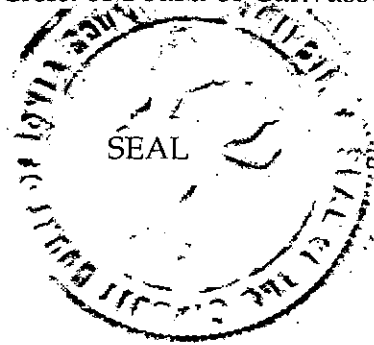
