**BOSTON TOWNSHIP
 AUTHORIZATION OF NEW ADDITIONAL MILLAGE TO
 PROVIDE FOR THE TOWNSHIP'S COST OF FIRE
 DEPARTMENT (INCLUDING FIRST RESPONDER
 EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICE) EXPENSES INCLUDING
 VEHICLES, APPARATUS AND EQUIPMENT**

Shall the limitation on general ad valorem taxes within Boston Township, as established by Article IX, Section 6 of the Michigan Constitution, be increased by .90 new additional mills (\$0.90 per \$1,000 of taxable value) upon all taxable real and personal property with the Township for a period of five (5) years, 2011 through 2015, inclusive, and shall the Township levy said millage, to provide for the Township's cost of fire department (including First Responder emergency medical service) expenses including vehicles, apparatus and equipment?

This is a request for new additional millage.

If approved, it is estimated that the levy of .90 mills will provide revenue of \$149,122 in the first calendar year of the levy.

The tax revenue received by the Township will be disbursed to the Township of Boston and the Saranac Community Volunteer Fire Department to provide for the Township's cost of fire department (including First Responder emergency medical service) expenses including vehicles, apparatus and equipment.
