

Section 308. Private Property. The Animal Control Officer and/or his or her designee are hereby authorized and empowered, in accordance with the provisions of this Ordinance, upon probable cause and issuance of a warrant, or unless a valid warrant exception exists including plain view or exigent circumstances, to enter upon private premises for the purpose of examining, capturing, or rescuing any animal, or to conduct inspections of all properties in conjunction with the fulfillment of the duties and responsibilities in this Ordinance. The provisions of this sub-section shall specifically include investigation of or seizure for cruelty to or neglect of animals.
