

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

For Improvements to Morrison Lake and the Special Assessment Roll for Morrison Lake

TAKE NOTICE that the Morrison Lake Improvement Board will hold a public hearing on the practicability of a five-year improvement project for Morrison Lake consisting of nuisance aquatic plant control, inspection and oversight, water quality monitoring, watershed management, information dissemination and education, engineering, administration, and contingencies. The hearing will be held at Campbell Township Hall, 331 S. Main St., Clarksville, Michigan, on Monday, August 26, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE that a special assessment roll has been prepared and is on file at the office of the Ionia County Drain Commissioner located at 100 West Main, Ionia, Michigan, for public examination during normal business hours. Said special assessment roll has been prepared for the purpose of assessing the cost of the improvement project to benefiting properties.

NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN that the Morrison Lake Improvement Board will hold a hearing immediately following the aforementioned hearing of practicability for the purpose of reviewing said special assessment roll and for hearing any objections thereto. An owner of or party with interest in real property to be assessed or his/her agent may appear in person to object to the special assessment or may protest such special assessment by letter filed with the Lake Board at or prior to the time of the hearing. Written objections may be filed with or mailed to the Morrison Lake Improvement Board c/o Ionia County Drain Commissioner's Office, 100 West Main, Ionia, MI 48846. Notice is also given that the owner of any real property within the Morrison Lake Special Assessment District who, having made an objection to said special assessment either in person or in writing, may, within thirty (30) days after the confirmation of the special assessment roll, appeal such special assessment to the Michigan Tax Tribunal or other court of competent jurisdiction.
